SOLONS OPPOSE HARTLEY'S PLAN FOR CONTROL BODY

(Associated Press Leased Wire.)

OLYMPIA, Wash., Jan. 6.—Voting criticism of Governor Hartley's recommendations, both for the management of the state school system and the state printing of text books, the senate committee on education, to which was referred the governor's recommendations on schools, tendered its report to the senate today.

At the outset of the report the committee declared that "it is now clear from the actual events of this legislative session that the education of the young people of this state has been made a chief political issue."

In commenting upon the governor's proposal to place administration of all school affairs "from the kindergarten to the university," in the hands of a non-salaried lay board of nine members to be appointed by the governor, the committee report again brings up the possibility of political encroachment.

"He, (the governor) offers a new method which guarantees that such a board is not to become subservient to the political doctrines and prejudices of the governor himself," the report reads.

The report condemns the idea of the proposed non-salaried lay board, pointing out that members of the present boards of regents and trustees of the five state institutions devote their time to single institutions at a considerable sacrifice and scouts the proposal that a single board undertake the management of all five institutions and the grade and high schools as well.
