**FIVE PEOPLE ARE BURNED TO DEATH**

(Associated Press Leased Wire.)  
**DOWAGIAC, Mich., Feb. 4**—The spectre of murder and suicide arose today from the ashes of the William Wilkinson farm home on Magician Lake, when officers found that the skulls of two of the five members of the family, who lost their lives had been crushed. The charred bodies of Wilkinson, 65, his wife, 60, his son Floyd, 25, his unmarried daughter, Gineith, 27, and the latter's three-day-old baby, were taken from the ruins of the house at daybreak.

Examination showed the skulls of Gineith and Floyd had been crushed. The theory of the officers is that the father, crazed by the birth of a girl to his daughter, killed her and her brother, then set fire to the dwelling.

**CASSPOLIS, Mich., Feb. 4**—Five persons, all members of the same family, were burned to death early today, when fire of undetermined origin destroyed the home of William Wilkinson, on the shore of Magician Lake near here.

County officers were told that the father had made veiled threats since the birth of a daughter's child.
