WATER PROJECTS OF WEST FARE WELL IN APPROPRIATIONS (Associated Press Leased Wire.) WASHINGTON, March 13.—Two more of the annual appropriation bills carrying a total of approximately \$306,000,000 were reported today to the senate from the appropriation committee. One for the Interior Department totals \$225,950,418 and the other for the state, justice, commerce and labor departments carries \$80,119,991. A fund of \$100,000 is provided for experimental financial aid to settlers on the reclamation projects in accordance with the compromise agreement between senators from western states and Secretary Work. Other additions made by the committee for reclamation projects included \$12,000 to the house total of \$72,000 for the Mill River project in Montana, and \$25,000 for the Bellfourche project in South Dakota, making its total \$65,000. The committee also added \$25,000 for federal assistance to Idaho, Montana, Oregon and Washington in the allocation of the waters of the Columbia river. An additional \$450,000 was added to the bill for the construction of the Coolidge dam near San Carlos, Arizona.
