### PREHISTORIC FORT FOUND IN KENTUCKY

(Associated Press Leased Wire.) LEXINGTON, Ky., May 1. — Discovery of a pre-historic fort in a "lost world" in the Kentucky mountains was announced today. Professor W. G. Burroughs of Berea College, the south's largest mountain school, told the Kentucky academy of science in annual convention today that the fort, half mile south of Indian fort mountain, explored by him, and one of the largest prehistoric forts in the nation, probably is several thousand years old. The "lost world" in Madison county extends 200 acres within two grim sets of cliffs, 50 to 200 feet high. Prehistoric armor, made from pure Lake Superior copper, was unearthed by the professor, who tripped over skeletons which had been lying flat for centuries after a consuming rite to the God of Fire.

### FINE WEATHER FOR BIG RELAY EVENT

(Associated Press Leased Wire.) SEATTLE, May 1.—Fair skies and light breezes were predicted for the annual University of Washington relay carnival here today, with Charles Hoff of Norway appearing as the main attraction in an attempt to break the world's pole vault record. The Universities of Oregon, Montana, Idaho and Washington, Washington State College and Oregon Agricultural College were the conference schools entered. A 120-yard high hurdle was included in the program for the first time. Two of the records are held by teams from Corvallis, they are: Two mile relay 8 minutes 5.5 seconds, held by Rankin, Dodge, Snyder, and Booth of Oregon Agricultural College. Four mile relay 18 minutes 3 seconds, held by Bell, Butts, Mason and Clayton of Oregon Agricultural College.

KLAMATH FALLS, Ore., May 1.—First death of the season due to the mysterious malady known as spotted or tick fever occurred here today, when Mrs. Winnie Souza, wife of a Mount Dome, California, rancher, died in a local hospital. One other reported case is on the way to recovery. The disease is carried by ticks, becoming most virulent during the spring and summer months, when the insects are most active.
