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ANCIENT JEWISH CITY FOUND WELL PRESERVED

(Associated Press Special Wire) JERUSALEM, May 7.—Excavation on the site of the buried city of Kirjath Sepher, in southern Palestine, has revealed one of the most complete and well preserved of Canaanite and Israelite walled cities.

The discovery was made by the archaeological expedition headed by Dr. Melvin G. Kyle, president of the Xena Theological Seminary of St. Louis in cooperation with the American school of Oriental research at Jerusalem. The uncovered walls are forty feet high and to fourteen feet thick. An extensive system of galleries and rooms for storing grain and water supplies was found.
