DOUGLAS COUNTY MEN FILE APPLICATIONS FOR WATER DIVERSION

The following applications for permits to appropriate water have been filed with the state engineer at Salem:

Grant Winters, Camas Valley, Douglas county, for 0.1 cubic feet per second from unnamed creek, tributary of Coquille river, for irrigation of eight acres. The ditch to be one-eighth mile in length. A log crib dam and log or timber headgate to be used; cost, \$400.

John J. Rathkey, Looking Glass, Douglas county, for 0.2 cubic feet per second from Ten Mile creek, tributary of South Umpqua river, for irrigation and power. The ditch to be one-quarter mile in length. A timber crib dam and timber headgate to be used. Fifteen acres to be irrigated; cost, \$2,000.
