ED WALKER CLAIMS MANY DEER KILLED BY GUNS IN CANYON

(Continued from page 1.)

In fact there are evidence to point to that belief, but it is my opinion that more of the animals were killed by bullets than died from the effects of spray and I believe the railroad company should have the benefit of that fact.

Mr. Walker early this week sent the following letter to the state game commission:

"Yesterday I investigated the report of deer dying along the railroad in Cow Creek canyon. I find there are many deer dead along the railroad, and most of them have been dead too long to tell whether or not they have been shot. I found one, however, that showed the bullet hole thru the shoulder very plain.

"I believe the railroad company should be compelled to use spray through the canyon that would not kill the deer as I understand they have a spray that is not poison."

This was followed by another letter which read:
"Since writing you yesterday regarding dead deer along the Southern Pacific right of way, I have talked with several railroad men who claim they have seen signal men and track walkers carrying guns at night along the track. They also report that the freight train crews shoot from the trains in passing through the canyon."

"This same thing existed a couple of years ago and I had the game department take the matter up with E. L. King, superintendent of this division and he issued orders and had them posted through the district that stopped the trouble for a while. I believe orders as mentioned above to track walkers, signal men and freight train crews would do a lot of good."
