**MARRIAGE LICENSE RECORD BROKEN**

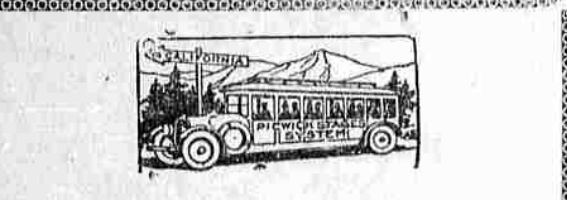
