### EUGENE PREPARES FOR BIGGEST FETE IN HER HISTORY

EUGENE, Ore., July 10.—With organization with Eugene fast approaching a stage of perfection, Trail-to-Rail celebration leaders have reached out to the surrounding communities and have asked for their cooperation in the days of entertainment, parades and pageantry that will mark the completion of the Eugene-Klamath Falls cutoff line of the Southern Pacific railroad.

In a letter to representative men and organizations of the cities in this part of the state, full details of what is sought were explained. Requests for floats, music and representation of the communities here by a princess to assist Queen Summa in ruling over the celebration is given. According to the plan, each community will send a princess to attend the pageant queen.

Rehearsals for the pageant are under way and the spectacle is expected to be the greatest of its kind in this section of the country. Local organizations are putting up their candidates for queen of the celebration, and the queen contest will open Monday. "Queen Summa, belle of the trail," will be her official title. Robert Kokyudall of Klamath Falls, will be "King Klamath."

The Trail-to-Rail celebration will be August 10-20.

## WRANGLER ISLAND AGAIN OBJECTIVE OF HOMESEEKERS

(Associated Press Local Wire.)

NOME, Alaska, July 10.—This expedition was today on its way to colonize Wrangel Island, in the Arctic ocean north of Siberia, and rename it Lenin Mitroff. The expedition, in a Russian icebreaker, the Krasny Oktabr (Red October) was scheduled to leave East Cape, Siberia, the west side of Bering Strait, June 25, for the island, or Mitroff, rediscovered in memory of Nikolai Lenin, considered the creator of Soviet Russia.

To Wrangel Island, for whose exploration and colonization loss of 18 lives in three expeditions, four of whom was Lenin Knight of St. Minnville, Ore.) has been listed in 13 years, the Krasny Oktabr was taking 29 families of Chukchees (Siberian Eskimos), 160 dogs and 21 reindeer. Equipment of the colony included 3,000 reindeer pelts for clothing and six umiaks, or harpoon Eskimo skin boats.

Provisions on the Red October for Lenin Mitroff were calculated to last three years.

Those here familiar with the history of Wrangel Island, or Lenin Mitroff, pronounce it uninhabitable. This because of cold, inaccessibility, absence of fuel and extreme scarcity of food.

95 At La Grande

LA GRANDE, July 10.—At one o'clock this afternoon the mercury was at 95 above, one degree warmer than yesterday's maximum of 94.

Cloudy At Klamath Falls

KLAMATH FALLS, July 10.—Clouds today gave promise of abating the heat, which shortly after noon reached 92, six degrees below the record set June 29.

Medford 100 At Noon

MEDFORD, July 10.—The mercury jumped from 88 Thursday to 102 Friday and street thermometers at noon today recorded 100.

101 At Pendleton

PENDLETON, July 10.—At noon today the thermometer here registered 101. Friday it was 94.

106 At Salem

SALEM, Ore., July 10.—The heat record of Salem for 1925 degrees, reached August 2, 1925, was shattered today when the mercury had climbed at 106 at 2 o'clock. The minimum throughout last night was 72.

Lack of a breeze made the heat particularly oppressive and four cases of prostration had been reported since noon yesterday, three of them farm hands.

Forest Fires In Lane

EUGENE, July 10.—A large forest fire is burning south of Alsea in northern Lane county, according to R. S. Shelley, supervisor of the Siuslaw National Forest. The exact location of the blaze has not been determined, but it is believed to be in the Oregon and California grant land territory and in private holdings.

The fire appears to be burning in green timber. Several forest fires were reported to the office of the Cascade National Forest here yesterday. Fire fighters were sent out after the fire was located by the forest air patrol, and the blazes are believed to be under control today.

102 At Eugene

EUGENE, July 10.—All heat records for the season were broken here today when the thermometer registered 102 degrees at 2 p. m. The minimum last night was 60 degrees.

Washington Areas Ablaze

OLYMPIA, Wash., July 10.—With prevailing weather conditions creating extensive fire hazards throughout the state of Washington, numerous forest fires were reported to the Superior of Forestry George C. Joy today. Approximately 200 men are combating the various blazes throughout the state.

District Warden H. P. Vane, of Olney, reported a fire of about 700 acres on Adams mountain, near Leavenworth. The fire was being tried to control. The fire near Tubb near the workings of the Curvey Brothers Logging company and the Mutual Lumber company is believed to be under control. District Warden C. P. Round reported the fire destroyed two logging road bridges, two double engines, considerable equipment and damaged a considerable quantity of logs. It burned over about 1500 acres before being checked, Roundtree said.

New fires were reported on Linn Island in Whitman county, near Oakes in Clallam county, in addition to a number of smaller brush fires. Hazardous fire weather is forecast for the next few days.
