CHAFING DISH DELICACIES

TOMORROW'S MENU: Breakfast: Grapefruit, Cereal, Wholewheat Griddlecake, Syrup, Coffee. Dinner: Olives, Fricassee of Chicken, Dumplings, Potatoes, Escalloped Tomatoes, Raisin Pie, Coffee. Supper: Egg Delight (in the Chafing Dish), Vegetable Salad, Lemon Layer Cake, Preserves, Tea.

Welsh Rarebit: (Some recipes for this dish call for ale or beer, but this recipe uses milk instead.) Fill the upper pan with boiling water and put in place; when water is scalding, cook the following mixture in the upper pan.

Egg Delight: Chop one cupful of smoked dried (chipped) beef very small. Cook it for several seconds in your chafing dish in three table-spoons of butter, then add one cupful of stewed or canned tomatoes and one-half cup of finely-chopped mild American cheese.

Chicken à la King: Melt five table-spoons of butter in the upper part of your chafing dish, over a simmering water, and in this butter cook three table-spoons of minced green sweet peppers (dill soft). Then stir in three table-spoons of bread flour, one-half teaspoon of salt, a pinch of pepper, and thin with two cups of milk, sweet top-milk or thin sweet cream.
