AGED SCULPTOR LEAPS TO DEATH FROM HIGH TOWER

WESTBURY, N. Y., Aug. 20—A card bearing the words "Mrs. Whitney you win; Tanthan, you lost" was found in the pocket of a 74-year-old sculptor, who leaped to his death from a 100-foot water tower on the Long Island estate of Mrs. Harris Payne Whitney.

Tanthan is the nickname of the sculptor's son, Galton Ardisson, Jr., who found the card in his father's pocket after the body was picked up yesterday.

Ardisson had been assistant and advisor to Mrs. Whitney in her sculptural work for 14 years.

What was meant by the sculptor when he wrote the first part of the note—"Mrs. Whitney, you win"—could not be explained. Mrs. Whitney is at Newport.
