LIBERTY THEATRE

A three-way combination, responsible for the success of "He Who Gets Slapped," has made another ten-strike.

In his latest motion picture production, co-starring Chaney and Norma Shearer, Sjöström is said to have made an even better film than "He Who Gets Slapped."

This production, "The Tower of Lies," produced for Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer, is to be seen at the Liberty.

ANTLERS THEATRE
OBSCURE TOWN GAINS FAME IN "ROLLING HOME"

The tiny town of Fallbrook, California, will burst into international fame, if anonymous fame, in "Rolling Home," William A. Seltzer's Universal production starring Reginald Denny, which comes to the Antlers theatre Friday-Saturday.

Fallbrook is an energetic but diminutive town about midway between Los Angeles and San Diego, and it has never regarded itself as a movie location until the arrival of Denny and his company.

Whereas ten years of experience have proven the entire practicability of eliminating diphtheria from a community by widespread immunization of children, and more particularly of children from one to five years of age, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Oregon State Board of Health with the best interests of the children of Oregon at heart, strongly urge upon the people of Oregon the opportunity thus afforded them of banishing diphtheria as a menace to their children, and be it further

Resolved, that the board urge upon fathers and mothers of the state that they seek this protection for their young children either from their family physicians, or by taking advantage of immunization service offered by local boards of health to the end that diphtheria be eliminated from the state of Oregon.
