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QUEEN MARIE WILL SEE CAROL BEFORE TRIP TO AMERICA

PARIS, Oct. 8.—Queen Marie of Rumania will see her son, Carol, the deposed crown prince, some time before her departure for the United States on the Leviathan next Tuesday, her aide de camp admitted today.

There was much curiosity as to whether Queen Marie of Rumania would consent to see her errant son, who is said to be residing near Paris with his innamorata, Magda Lupescu, the titan-haired daughter of a Jewish merchant of Jassy.

Reports of high times had by Carol during a recent visit to Biarritz have reached the queen and are declared to have added to her agitation due to his escapade in leaving home and denouncing the throne.

It is understood, however, that Queen Marie's sister, the queen of Yugoslavia, has pleaded hard with Marie not to leave on the long journey to the United States still estranged from her son.

REDDING, Calif., Oct. 8.—Criminal action against F. M. Christian, manager of the Sims Lumber and Box company, or alleged failure to pay his employees was taken here yesterday by representatives of the state labor commission.

Christian is believed to be in San Francisco. Simultaneously, proceedings were started to foreclose loggers' liens on the company's property at Sims in behalf of 73 workers claiming \$6,629 due them for wages. The workers claim that they have not been paid in nearly three months and that their families are in dire need.
