**BROWN ESTATE EAST OF CITY SOLD TO W. A. PEARCE**

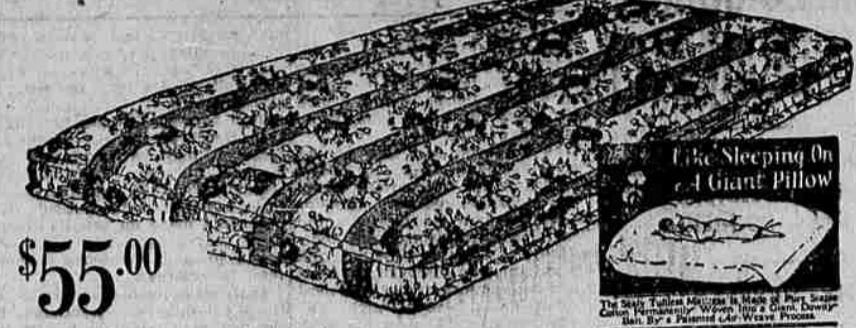
