MINOR DAMAGE DONE TO ROADS WITHIN COUNTY

Reports of minor damage to the roadways throughout the county as a result of the heavy rains Sunday and Monday, continued to filter in to the county court today. In numerous places culverts proved to small to carry off the surplus water and the gravel on the roadbeds was washed away. A 10-foot bridge on the Pinkerton section of the Dixonville Carnes loop was washed out, while a small bridge on the road to Green was slightly damaged, when the water went around each end, cutting out the approaches.

A piece of road near Umpqua was saved only by a narrow margin, when water running through a stockway threatened to carry out a fill. Through efforts of the workmen, however, the destruction of the road was prevented.

According to Floyd Frear, county engineer, the road crews in all districts have been hard at work preventing road damage, as much as possible, and despite the seriousness of the flood the loss within the county has been negligible. The most serious damage was on the Scottsburg-Elkton road, where about 80 feet of roadway was washed out. This adjoined the section of road washed out last year, the stream having undermined the roadway, which followed the slope of a steep hill with the creek directly beneath. A temporary trestle has been built to provide a way through.

PLEA OF NEGRESS REVEALS KLAMATH FALLS JAIL BREAK

KLAMATH FALLS, Ore., Dec. 1.—Frantic plea of Mrs. Ed McClinden, negress, phoned to local officers last night, led to the discovery that her husband and five others had made a successful escape from the county jail by sawing out iron window bars and sliding down a blanket ladder to freedom.

Mrs. McClinden phoned, police that her husband, against whom she had filed divorce proceedings, was endeavoring to break into the back door of her cottage and said she feared for her life.

Sheriff Burt Hawkins, visiting with Chief of Police Harry Loucks, heard the message with amazement. A quick checkup of county jail prisoners revealed six missing and subsequent investigation showed the manner of escape.

Up to early this afternoon officers had no trace of the fleeing men.

Those who escaped were: Lee Gray, awaiting trial upon the charge of larceny; Ed McClinden, charged with the issuance of bad checks; Jack Saunders, awaiting trial upon the charge of larceny of a car; J. F. Eckstrom, serving one year upon conviction of possession and transportation of illicit whiskey; Red Henderson, charged with violation of the prohibition law; Emilio Reginaldo, charged with violation of the prohibition law.

WILLAMETTE IS FALLING

EUGENE, Ore., Dec. 1.—The Willamette river went down to the nine foot level last night, dropping from 14 feet. Precipitation here during the past 24 hours was but .31 of an inch and prospects are for a further drop in the stage of the river.

Only once in the past thirteen years has there been more rainfall in November than the record of precipitation in Eugene for the month just past, according to Gerard M. Debroekert, local weather observer. During the past month the precipitation was 10.75 inches. In November, 1915, the precipitation was 11.86 inches.

STATE MAY COMPROMISE ROSS ISLAND DISPUTE
