Men Who Made the World

FERNANDO CORTEZ

FROM HIS FOREBARS, WHO, AFTER HERGIC STRUGGLES, HAD FREED HIM FROM MOORISH DOMINATION, HE INHERITED AN ARDENT PATRIOTISM, CLOSELY BOUND UP WITH RELIGION, AS A LOVER OF DARING FOR GAMBLES' SAKE, HE HAS NEVER BEEN ECLIPSED. THE DEEDS OF THESE MEN READ MORE LIKE A TROUBADOUR'S TALE THAN THE SOBER PAGES OF HISTORY.

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HORRORS OF WAR SHOWN IN BATTLE IN NICARAGUA

(Associated Press Leased Wire.)

MANAGUA, Nicaragua, Jan. 3.—Final reports of the three-day battle last week at Las Perlas (Pearl Lagoon) show it to have been the bloodiest of the present war between the forces of the Diaz conservative government, recognized by the United States, and the Saca liberal government, recognized by Mexico. (Previous dispatches said the liberals were victorious, the conservatives retiring their main body to El Bluff, where they were disarmed by the American naval authorities. Their rear guard was overcome by the liberals.)

Of the 1800 liberals and 1300 conservatives engaged 302 were killed and 150 wounded. It is impossible to give the respective losses from these totals, the dispatches say.

No attempt was made to bury the dead, and many of the wounded crawled off into the swamps to die. Thousands of villagers are hovering over the battlefield.

Sherman's Definition
Frank R. Mitchell, world war veteran and soldier of fortune, in many Central American revolutions, today termed the scene after the battle as indescribable.

"Hard boiled as I am," he said, "I have to turn away. I have never seen such sights in my career, not even in the World War, due to the lack of attention for the wounded."

The commander of the conservative army announces it will be necessary to call out every able-bodied man between the ages of 13 and 50. He has received requests from American and other foreign planters to allow the laborers to proceed with the coffee harvest, but says the laborers must go to the front.

Mexico Accused
Charges of Mexican intervention in Nicaragua are made in a statement issued by Adolfo Diaz, president of the conservative government, in power here.

Another filibustering expedition which he alleges was outfitted by the Mexican government is expected shortly on the Nicaraguan Pacific coast, General Diaz says, and forces are preparing to repel it.

The expedition, he asserts, is the third "sent by the Calles government against Nicaragua," and consists of arms, ammunition, airplanes and Mexican military personnel.

(Spokesmen for the liberal government have denied receiving military aid from Mexico, declaring the arms shipped from that country to Nicaragua were purchased there with funds supplied by the liberals themselves. One spokesman said that possibly 15 Mexican volunteers are fighting for Saca.)

Would Recall Marines
WASHINGTON, Jan. 3.—Immediate withdrawal of American Marines and warships from Nicaragua was asked in a resolution introduced today by Senator Wheeler, democrat, Montana.

The Montana senator has charged the activities of American forces in the Central American republic are in violation of both the American and Nicaraguan constitutions.

Besides declaring that American lives and American property in Nicaragua are not now and never have been in danger, the resolution sharply assails the state department both for recognizing the Diaz government and for sending American armed forces to the country.
