FEDERAL FILING ON VALE PROJECT FAVORABLE SIGN

SALEM, Ore., Jan. 12—Early construction of the Vale reclamation project by the United States reclamation service is indicated by an application received from the federal government by State Engineer Rhea Luper for the appropriation of 200 second feet from the direct flow of the Malheur river and seepage water and 600 second feet of storage water from the Warm Springs reservoir.

The land to be reclaimed by the government lies mainly along the north side of the Malheur river, centering about Harper and Vale.

INFLAMMATIONS AROUND THE NAILS.

Inflammation around the roots of the nails is known by the technical name of Paronychia. The condition may be caused by similar things that cause inflammation elsewhere—injuries, pus infections, ringworm and other skin diseases, and certain systemic diseases.

Treatment: Soak the hands in hot water containing a teaspoonful of bicarbonate of soda to the quart of water, and then use some antiseptic such as boracic acid powder, or paint with iodine once a day.
