EUREKA, Calif., April 8.—Dr. James A. Hadley, prominent Arcata physician, is held at the county jail here charged with first degree murder as the result of the death here yesterday of Louise Baxendale, 19, of Berkeley. The complaint was sworn to last night by District Attorney R. E. Metzler, who charges that the girl died as the result of an illegal operation. The murder charge was filed following a "full and detailed confession" obtained from Walter Thayer, a youth who arrived here with Miss Baxendale, Monday from Oakland, for the purpose, the youth confessed, of having the illegal operation performed.
