They talk peace and get ready for war. It has taken them a century and a half to get this good start, but now they have it going big.

THE RED MOVEMENT

In discussing this topic, one is obliged to mention facts and tendencies which challenge credulity. It is difficult for us to believe, unless we have studied the matter carefully, that there exists a well-organized and sufficiently financed force endeavoring to overthrow the Constitution and Government of our Republic. But such is the fact. And furthermore, this same movement intends to confiscate all private property, to drive out of our hearts all sense of national loyalty. Not content with these results, it would crush in the human heart all religious sentiments, and then would invade our homes to blot out marriage and family relationships. I could not take such a program seriously were it not for the fact that it has been gathering headway for 151 years and is at this hour powerful in many sections of the earth, our own land being included.

But to understand it correctly, we must know its history, and the things it advocates, and its methods of work, and the people supporting it. I shall give you this information. In doing this, I wish to state that the facts here mentioned are taken largely from the Congressional Record of the United States. That ought to be sufficiently authoritative for us all.

Inception of "Red" Movement

May 1st, 1776, the Order of the Illuminati was established in Bavaria. This organization was the parent of the extreme Communist form of government we see in the world today. Please notice the date of their inception, just two months and four days before our Declaration of Independence was

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Alarmingly interesting is the story of the acquisition of Russia. Under the Czar an intolerable condition existed and Russia was at war with Germany. As a military move Germany sent Lenin, a follower of Karl Marx and of the Order of the Illuminati, into Russia to stir up civil strife and get the Russians to killing each other. Then in the following confusion Germany could transfer most of the armed States for Joseph Rubenstein, who for a number of years was an I. W. W. agitator right here in the West. They took him to Russia and changed his name to Joseph Rubinsky, and recently he was shot by the Bulgarian government for bombing the Sophia Cathedral. And it is certain

that Nicholas Bukharin, publisher of a radical paper in New York, was called to Russia and he is there now at the head of their Communist propaganda work. These men and others set up "The Third International" in Russia, which is the present ruling power there.

To the world they talked peace and brotherhood and the rights of the classes, the people. But they set out to fit themselves into positions of power with guns and swords. And in doing this they killed upwards of two million of their own people. We are told by Professor Sorokin, of the University of Petrograd, that in four years following 1917 they slew more than 1,750,000 souls. Of this number 6000 were teachers, 3000 physicians, 12,950 land-owners, 70,000 policemen, 355,000 intelligentsia (educated class), 133,280 workers, 315,000 peasants, etc. Any man who opposed their ideas in any way was slain.

These are just a few facts on the inception and historical development of the Red Movement. You may find these and similar facts on the Congressional Record of the United States.

Their Objectives

They are six in number, were adopted in Bavaria, May 1st, 1776, and are today the objectives of the Reds in Europe, Asia and America. In 151 years their objectives have not changed in the slightest. Here they are:

1. Abolition of government as it is. Tear it down, cripple its force, drive its people into desperate confusion, and then when it is at its worst, step in with force to establish another international.

2. Abolition of patriotism and national loyalty. They try to bring this about by preaching the doctrine of "The Internationale Mind." Citizens of no country is what they want at first, and later they will see that you line up with their country.

3. Abolition of property rights. You are not supposed to own anything. Your business, home, the garments you wear are not property yours but belong to the state.

4. Abolition of inheritance.

5. Abolition of all religion, especially the Christian religion. They cannot live comfortably with the latter and do their work. It would tear down our churches, burn our Bibles and stifle our hopes.

6. And finally the abolition of marriage and home relationships. But are the sexes to mingle in the welfare organizations, and I admit that some of them are in the pulp they mingle intimately, but not upon a marriage basis. Any children are to be supported and trained in institutions by the state.

All six of these objectives are advocated in every European nation where they operate. But in

Great Britain and the United States they say little of the last two for the present.

Their Methods

Revolution and physical power in Europe. In the United States and Britain legislation, education and propaganda.

Present Day Results

The achievements of the Reds in Russia are well known and I will only call your attention to the fact that in Russia about 800,000 Reds are ruling 180,000,000 people, and they are doing it with guns. These figures will be denied by them, as they claim they have ten million Reds in Russia, but careful students of the question in Russia and America place their numbers at six hundred thousand.

The situation in Germany is not easily reduced to figures, but many feel that hidden away there in that land some of the most powerful forces of the extreme Communist movement are waiting for a favorable hour to arise and strike.

In recent weeks the daily press has made us well aware of the power of the Reds in China. The outcome of the struggle there no man can accurately tell at the present moment. China is arising out of the ashes of 40 or 50 centuries and she has discovered that while she was asleep her body was quartered and hung up in the sea to cure. But half a dozen powerful men in different parts of the empire are trying to assemble her parts. The passion of China now is for nationality. The Reds have come in to help them get it, seizing upon their confused condition to take possession of their land with their teachings. Consequently, the Reds have backed the Chinese people as the most likely to succeed. That victorious Cantonese army was organized and trained and financed by Russian Reds. But within a few days there have been clear intimations that the Chinese people will resist them and drive them out.

But your interest and mine is most of all in our own land. As already stated their method of operation here is legislation and propaganda. Their points of attack are congress and state legislatures, our entire school system, farmers' organizations, labor unions, the churches, the women's clubs. By directing the energies and purposes of these, they will in time shape public opinion and then follow with the bloodless revolution which they feel will appeal to our land.

First of all confusion must be established. Just about anything which will hog the Uncle Sam and render him helpless will answer their purpose. So, in our schools and clubs and churches and unions of various names, they have in training a fine army of calamity advocates. They are in the clubs of the rich, in the unions of the poor, in the colleges and schools, in the welfare organizations, and I admit that some of them are in the pulp they mingle intimately, but not upon a marriage basis. 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Yankee, President Wilson's treatment of Eugene Debs, our biased supreme court of the United States, our militaristic tendencies, our plan to grab Mexico some day, our inhuman prisons, our silly marriage laws, our dead churches, our unscientific and inaccurate Bible, our outgrown constitution of the republic are all matters that just howl in our ears endlessly. They are here to break down our loyalty to our country and its treasured institutions.

We find these people grouped in organizations like "The American Civil Liberties Union," "The Fellowship of Reconciliation," and "I. W. W." Just take a look at the first of these, The Hon. Francis Briston Welsh, of Philadelphia and Congressman Thomas L. Blanton, of Texas, have shown "The American Civil Liberties Union" to be a large and dangerous Red organization. Welsh tells us that its purpose is to deprive our country of every means of defending itself against enemies from without and within, and thus make possible a peaceful and civil strife. Recently the New York legislature carried on an investigation of revolutionary radicalism and found that Joseph N. Baldwin is recognized as the virtual leader, they call him "The Director" of the American Civil Liberties Union. They put Baldwin on the witness stand and they report that he used there the following words: "The advocacy of murder, unaccompanied by any act, is within the legitimate scope of free speech." And on the same occasion he is reported by that investigating committee of the N. Y. legislature to have said that "all of them believe in the right of persons to advocate the overthrow of government by force and violence." But who is this Roger N. Baldwin? He was a member of the old Berkman anarchist gang and helped to organize the "League for Amnesty of Political Prisoners," which was conceived and put over by Berkman when he was in jail and the purpose of it was to get himself and Tom Mooney out of jail. Now this society is considered the beginning of the "American Civil Liberties Union." And this A. M. C. L. crowd has supported criminals, dynamiters and murderers. As an instance, it upheld the brutal murder of our soldiers at Centralia, Washington.

On the national committee of the "American Civil Liberties Union" we find the names of William Z. Foster, a labor leader advocating the scrapping of all moral law and order; James A. Duncanson, of Seattle, who tried to put over an insurrection in the Seattle general strike in 1919; Oswald Garrison Villard, owner and editor of "The Nation"; Frank P. Walsh, devoted friend of the anarchist Berkman; Felix Frankfurter, of the Harvard law school; Morris Hillquit, New York, one of the keen legal minds of our time; Agnes Brown Leach, wife of Henry Goddard-Leach, of the Forum; Jane Addams, Hull House, Chicago; Scott Nearing, the Rev. John Haynes Holmes and many others. There are three Harvard professors in the Harvard law school training with this crowd, and Dean

Rogee Pound is one of them. Professor Lovett, Chicago university, is another of them, and so is Anna Louise Strong, now on the lecture platform in the east.

This Red movement plans to get its teachings into our common schools, and the authors of their text books are able people. Watch out for this thing when they get to changing text books in Oregon. They are hot after the clubs for women and bring to these clubs a smooth story. They come at the ministers and church people with their "international mind" talk and their anti-war propaganda. Before we know what we are doing, we are pulling their chestnuts out of the fire.

In their ranks are many fine people and we must feel that these fine people are sincere. The only reason I can give for their presence in companies of people who plan the destruction of our democratic form of government is the fact that they must have drifted down a stream of social reform until they now approach the brink of a deadly Niagara.

But we have on this continent the fairest, the most stable, the purest expression of "government of the people, by the people and for the people" that history has ever known. Our privileges in citizenship, in training and industry, in religion and in our homes, have been purchased at tremendous cost. It is not the land of social, industrial or religious slavery, but still our "land of the free, our home of the brave."

If it is that to you, then defend it against the increasing numbers of radical communism.

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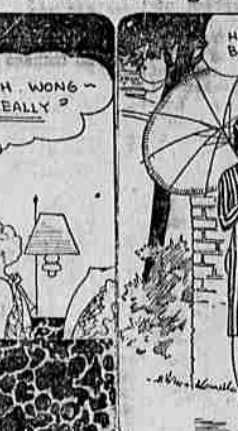
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
