Fluffy Biscuits

"Fluffy" is just the name for these lovely, light biscuits. A recipe by a well known cookery expert.

- 2 cups flour
- 4 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 2 tablespoons Crisco
- 3/4 cup milk, or half milk and half water

Sift together flour, baking powder and salt. Add Crisco and mix in very lightly with fork; add liquid slowly; roll or pat out with hands on floured board to about one inch of thickness (handle as little as possible); cut with biscuit cutter first dipped in flour. Bake in hot oven twelve or fifteen minutes.

This expert says:

Your biscuits will be light and tender if you will cut the Crisco into the sifted flour with two knives as in making pastry—instead of rubbing it in with your finger-tips.
