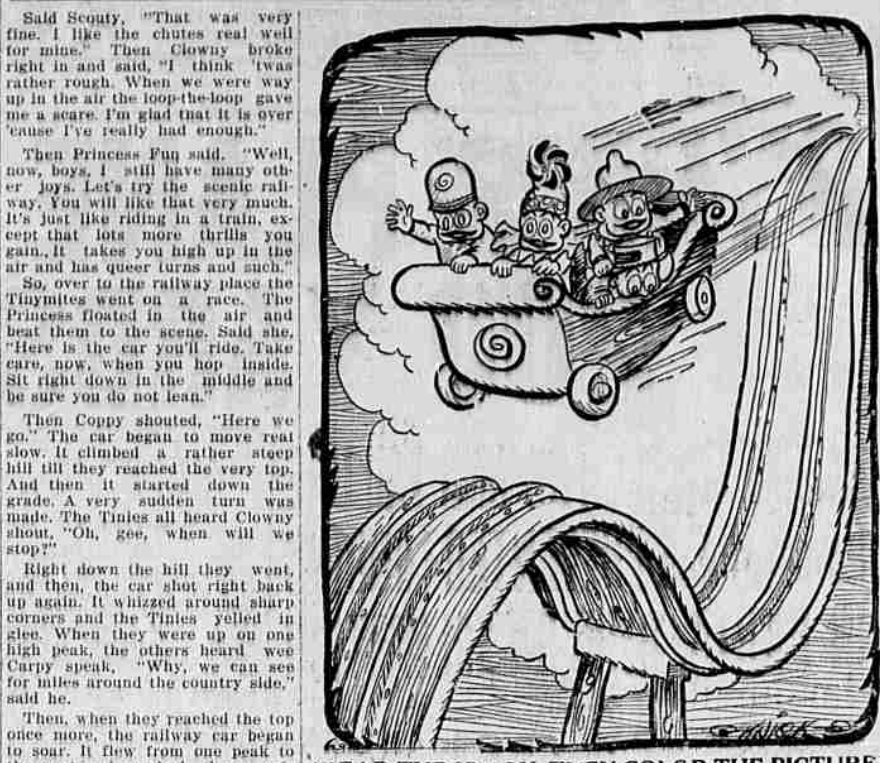
EXIT JUDGE LINSEY
