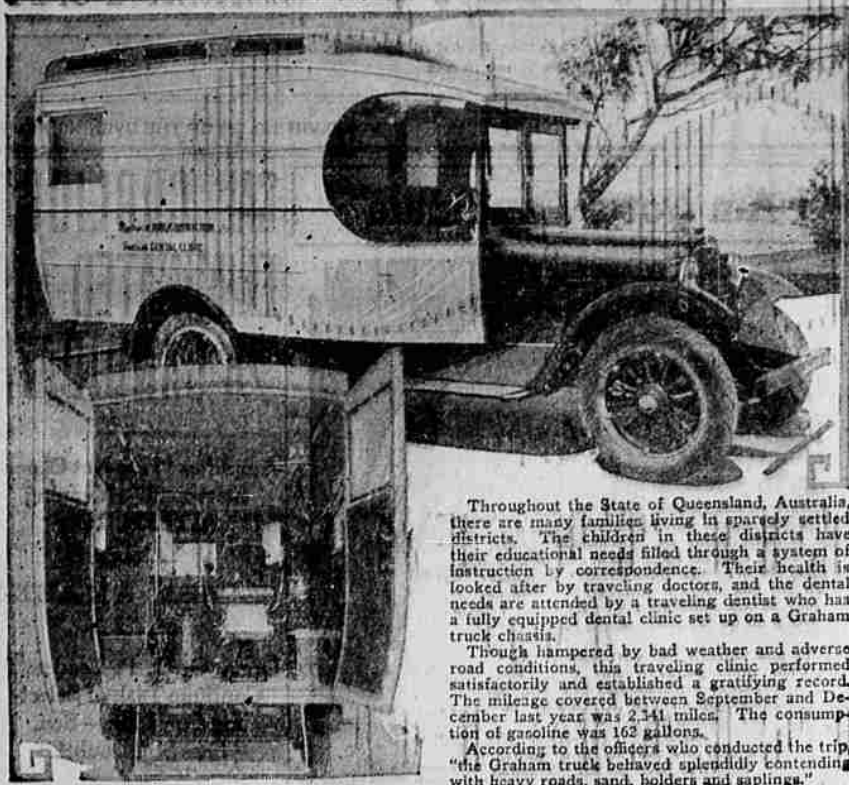


AUSTRALIA HAS TRAVELING DENTAL CLINIC MOUNTED ON GRAHAM TRUCK



Throughout the State of Queensland, Australia, there are many families living in sparsely settled districts. The children in these districts have their educational needs filled through a system of instruction by correspondence. Their health is looked after by traveling doctors, and the dental needs are attended by a traveling dentist who has a fully equipped dental clinic set up on a Graham truck chassis.

Though hampered by bad weather and adverse road conditions, this traveling clinic performed satisfactorily and established a gratifying record. The mileage covered between September and December last year was 2,141 miles. The consumption of gasoline was 163 gallons.

According to the officers who conducted the trip, "the Graham truck behaved splendidly contending with heavy roads, sand, holders and saplings."

PONTIAC-OAKLAND SALES CLIMB UP

PONTIAC, Mich., Dec. 7.—A third assembly line for the Pontiac Six, duplicating the arrangement and equipment of the two lines already in operation, is being installed in the Pontiac Six assembly building at a cost of \$250,000. It is announced by A. R. Glancy, president and general manager of the Oakland Motor Car company.

Sustained demand for the Pontiac Six during the season when automobile sales normally are expected to decrease, and anticipation of still greater public acceptance in 1928, have prompted the company again to expand its production capacity, Mr. Glancy explained.

Together the three assembly lines will be able to produce 120 Pontiac Sixes per hour or one complete car every 30 seconds. The Pontiac Six factory thus will have a production capacity of 1080 cars per nine hour day. This, together with the 720-car daily capacity of the two new Oakland All-American Six assembly lines in the Oakland factory, will give a total capacity of 1800 automobiles during each nine hour day, or one unit every 18 seconds.

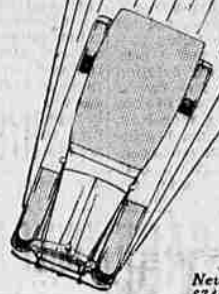
The car assembly plant, where the third Pontiac Six assembly line is being installed, is one of the \$12,000,000 group of buildings, finished early in 1927 which provided the Pontiac Six with separate factory. In anticipation of the eventual need for higher production, space for a third car assembly line was left between the two present assembly lines. This foresight

DISCOVER NEW TERRITORY

WASHINGTON, Dec. 7.—The United States Geological Survey has filled in another blank spot on the map of the world. In doing so it discovered a new river, a large lake and an active volcano.

The survey's Alaskan expedition of last summer has returned after mapping a territory of more than 2,000 square miles in the Alaskan ranges and adjacent country. This area heretofore has been shown as a blank and unknown space on the map of the world.

The party, headed by S. R. Capps, a geologist, discovered the river Chakachana, the drainage basin of which covers an area of more than 1,100 square miles. It's current has an average speed of 16 miles an hour. The river flows in what Mr. Capps described as a "superb lake, named Chakachana; 33 miles long, hemmed in behind lofty mountains and impounded behind a great glacier."

The mountain peaks in the section are rugged pinnacles. The highest peak is Mount Spurr. From its top a line of steam, rising a thousand feet into the air, could be seen, the party reported.
