BOYS WHO KILLED GRANDMOTHER WILL SERVE LIFE TERMS

DUBUQUE, Iowa, Jan. 21.—Two boys under 20, whose make-up of rouged cheeks, painted lips and pencilled eyebrows has given way to the pallor that follows two months in jail, began serving life sentences today for slaying the grandmother of one of them.
Leonard Cota, 18, of Altoona, Wis., and Howard Kramer, 19, of Malta, Montana, yesterday were sentenced to life imprisonment for killing Cota's maternal grandmother, Mrs. Elizabeth McKirkick, of Zwingle, Iowa.
It was the boys' "beauty" treatments that aroused the suspicion of St. Louis detectives and led to their arrest six days after they had bound and gagged Cota's grandmother and left her to die on the kitchen floor of her Zwingle home, while they looted the house. The youths found more than \$20,000 in cash and an equal amount in securities, nearly all of which was recovered.
The boys, in telling why they committed the robbery and murder, said that they wanted the money to finance their training to become opera singers.
