GIVEN ON POULTRY
HOUSE BUILDING

"Certain general principles apply to all poultry house construction," says M. A. Jull and A. H. Lee in a bulletin on "Poultry Houses and Fixtures," just published by the United States Department of Agriculture.

"The first essential in housing chickens or laying hens," the authors say, "is comfort, for unless chickens are comfortable they will not grow well, and pullets and hens will not lay well."

"The second essential," according to these poultry specialists, "is economy. A new house need not be expensive, but it should be durable; the more durable the house the less the cost of housing per year in a period of years."

"The third essential," they continue, "is convenience. The house should be conveniently located and should be of such shape and size that work in it can be done with ease. Too often the mistake of building small houses with low roofs is made, so that it is drudgery to care for the chicks or the layers."

IS GUIDE TO LIMING

Liming soils may bring about beneficial results in several ways. It stimulates the proper decomposition of organic matter, neutralizes acids, improves the physical condition of heavy soils, and gives lime to growing plants, or makes available other elements in the soil.

HOME POINTERS

(From School of Home Economics) One teaspoonful of brown sugar rubbed into a pork roast with the flour gives the roast additional flavor and a rich golden brown color.

Lemon juice improves the flavor of all relish dishes. For gelatin salads fresh fruits, vegetables or nuts are added after the mixture is cool because when added to a hot mixture they lose most of their flavor.

To hold a salad design in place, such as a salad of olive, a slice of fruit or a nut, arrange it in the mold, pour a thin layer of gelatin over it to congeal before adding the rest of the cooled gelatin. To place a design on the side of the mold dip it in gelatin and press it in place before adding the cooled liquid.

Evaporated milk and gelatin whipped together forms a very good substitute for whipped cream.

Too much water is one of the commonest causes for tough pie crust. In handling pastry work rapidly with a light touch and with as little extra flour as possible.

The trimmings from pie crust may be rolled into a sheet, cut in rounds or ovals and baked, then filled with jelly and whipped cream for serving.

A monogram on a dinner cloth is usually from three to four inches long and is placed above and to the right of the hostess' cover. On the dinner napkin it is placed in the exact center, the napkin being folded in thirds instead of fourths.

The correct position for bread and butter plates is above and to the right of the fork with the butter spreader placed diagonally across the rim.
