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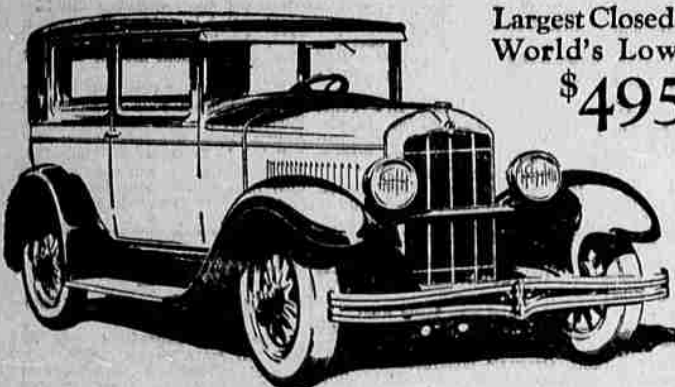

IN TWO YEARS WHIPPET FOUR PROVES WORTH

With production of the Whippet four-cylinder models nearing the end of their second year, a careful study of the entire history of the automobile industry shows that seldom, if ever before, has one model of any company gone through such a long period without requiring vital changes, either in the power plant or body design.

When the first Whippet was introduced in June, 1926, John W. Willys, president, declared that this new type of light four cylinder car was years in advance of any other automobile in the Whippet price class. That this statement was true is borne out in the adoption of certain Whippet features by other manufacturers of light four cylinder cars.

These included low center of gravity construction, 4-wheel brakes, economical, powerful and speedy engine and a performance rating that set an advanced standard in the light four field. Since its introduction, the Whippet four cylinder model has required only minor mechanical changes. This is said to be a tribute to the high degree of perfection and quality attained by the design and construction of this car. In the matter of body design few changes have been made during the past two years, except for the addition of various refinements. These include a cadet type sun shield, the employment of remote door controls, window reveals and additional standard equipment consisting of automatic windshield wiper, rear view mirror and rear driving and stop light.

These refinements were incorporated in the present Whippet, which was brought out in January, following a drastic price reduction which has placed these cars in direct price competition with the Ford models.

Willys-Overland merchants throughout the nation report that since early in 1928 the demand for these light four cylinder cars has been the greatest they have ever experienced. This is borne out in sales figures released by the Willys-Overland company at Toledo, which show that despite the greatest production period in the history of the company, it has been impossible to keep pace with the great influx of orders since early in January.

BALL SCORES IN MAJOR LEAGUES

While the Yankee machine rolls up an impressive lead in the American league, five clubs continue unabated their scramble for first division berths in John Heydler's circuit.

In sharp contrast is the situation in the National circuit where Brooklyn, in fifth place, is only three games and a half back of the league-leading Cincinnati Reds.

Durocher's triple with the bases full enabled the Yanks to beat the Senators in the first game of a double header, 3 to 2. They followed this with a crushing 12 to 3 triumph in the second engagement, blasting out nineteen hits including Babe Ruth's 17th and 18th homers of the season and Gehrig's 9th and 10th.

Beaten five times in six starts against the champions, the Philadelphia Athletics nevertheless showed their morale was not utterly shattered by pulling out a 4 to 3 verdict over the Boston Red Sox.

Meanwhile the National league leaders became more bunched than ever. The Chicago Cubs moved to within a game of the Reds by downing the league leaders, 4 to 6. The St. Louis Cardinals ousted the Dodgers from fourth place by taking an easy 7 to 1 victory over the crippled Pirates at Pittsburgh.

Charlie Robertson spoiled the opening game of the Phillies' first home stand by pitching the Braves to an easy 9 to 3 decision. George Sisler made his first appearance in a Boston uniform, scored two runs and got one of the Braves 12 hits.

Rain forced postponement of the Chicago-St. Louis American league game.
