And for a period of 30 days, beginning with Monday, July 23rd, and ending with Tuesday, August 21st, 1928, at the office of the State Engineer in the Capitol Building at Salem, Oregon.

Statements and proofs of claim of the various claimants will be received at said times and places from 9 a. m. to 12 m., and from 1 p. m. to 4 p. m. of each of said days.

And you are hereby required to appear at one of the times and places above named and submit proof of your claim to the use of waters of said stream or a tributary thereof, if any such right is claimed by you; and you are hereby further notified that if you fail to so appear and submit proof of your claim to said waters, default will be entered against you, and you will be barred and estopped from subsequently asserting any right to the use of said waters, and will be held and deemed to have forfeited all right to the use of said waters theretofore claimed by you.
