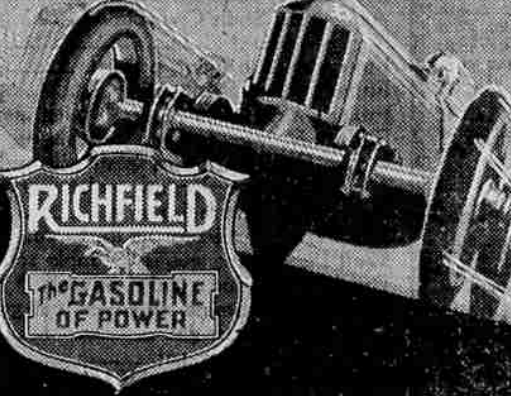

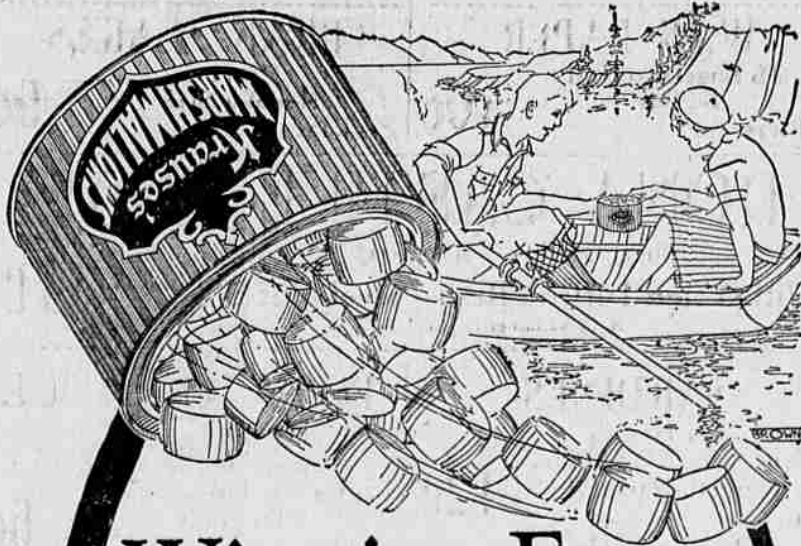

### LIQUOR ISSUE CRASHES GATE OF DEMOCRATS

nomination of the favorite will be assured.  
The dynamic Reed will throw himself wholeheartedly into the fight after his arrival and will have the assistance of such men of his organization as Sam Fordyce, his campaign manager, and Charles Howell, of Kansas City, who is to place his name before the convention.

Reed is not a delegate to the convention, but some thought has been given by his advisors to the advisability of having him take a seat by proxy, thus clearing the way for him to sit on the platform committee if he so wished and to address the convention if the situation shaped up so that he would regard this course as desirable.

There have been indications, however, that this course will not be followed. A definite decision awaits the arrival of the Missouri and conference he immediately begin with his political lieutenants and his leading supporters in several states.

#### Dryers Are Busy

The candidates and leaders actually opposing Smith have vigorous support from the dry organizations of the country, spokesmen for whom they are mapping out a program of rallies for Sunday and Monday in an effort to influence the delegates against the nomination of a candidate which they regard as wet.

Another candidate beside Reed will reach Houston today. He is George, of Georgia, who has the endorsement of his state organization and is expected to draw some strength from Florida, Alabama and perhaps South Carolina and some other of the southern states. George will open headquarters at the Rice hotel, where Smith, Reed, and Cordell Hull of Tennessee, already have their main convention offices.

#### Smith Stands Pat

NEW YORK, June 22.—Governor Alfred E. Smith's views on prohibition are unchanged.

He was asked by the New York World:

"In view of the questions raised at Houston about Norman E. Mack's statement, the World wishes to know: Have you changed your belief that there should be amendment of the present prohibition provisions?"

"I have not," the governor replied. Since passage of the prohibition amendment, Gov. Smith has maintained it was improper because adopted without a referendum to the people and that under the amendment each state should be privileged to decide its alcoholic content of its beverages.

The World, an ardent supporter of the governor for the democratic presidential nomination, and a foe of prohibition, has been urging him strongly not to straddle on the question.

#### Mack Amplifies

Mr. Mack, national committee man from New York and up-state democratic leader, had said:

"Governor Smith has stood and always will stand for personal liberty and state's rights. He is opposed to prohibition. He is for temperance."  
"Governor Smith believes that if any state desires a certain alcoholic content of beverage that state has the right to determine that content. If the state desires to be dry, then it is the right of the state to be dry."

When Mr. Mack's statement was construed as expressing the views of Gov. Smith, Mr. Mack hastened to say that he was speaking only for himself.

#### Smith Not to Resign

The governor refused to elaborate on his views after he had given his answer to The World's question.

The governor denied recent reports that he might resign his present office on receiving the presidential nomination.

"There is certainly nothing to that," he said.

When asked whether he desired to comment on who the vice-presidential nominee might be, he said: "I am not handling that end of it. That is something the convention is capable of working out. I believe that collective judgment in such matters is always best."

CALIFORNIA PEAR  
PRICE \$42 A TON  
FOR FIRST GRADE

SAN FRANCISCO, June 22.—California orchardists will receive \$42 a ton for number one coast Bartlett pears this year. This was confirmed today as the action of the annual price-fixing meeting of the California Pear Growers' association here this week.

The price of river Bartlett, which brought the growers \$59 a ton last year, was fixed at \$48 a ton this season. The crop is estimated at 226,000 tons with more than 50 per cent being first grade fruit.

Last year's crop of nearly 200,000 tons was sold on a \$44 a ton basis for the number one coast Bartlett. Picking this year will start the last week of June. Frank T. Sweet, association manager, predicted, with the peak being reached in August.

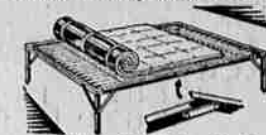

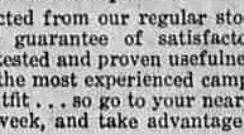

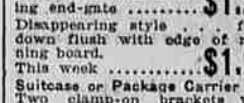
