UTILITIES PROBE SHOWS USE MADE OF HOOVER IDEAS

(Associated Press Leased Wire) WASHINGTON, Sept. 20.—Evidence, in the form of a \$644 check, introduced yesterday into the Federal Trade commission's investigation of power utilities disclosed that the National Electric Light association had purchased 49,500 copies of an address by Herbert Hoover delivered in October, 1925, for circulation throughout the country.

George F. Oxley of New York, director of public relations for the National Electric Light association, identified the check which was made out to Harold Phelps Stokes in the department of commerce, under date of October 28, 1925.

Steps taken by the New Jersey Utility association to keep in touch with legislation pending before the state legislature were traced during testimony by William H. Roth, secretary.

When Roth was excused temporarily, A. J. Marshall, New York, secretary of the National Electric Light association, took the stand and testified regarding the financial accounts of that organization.

At the outset he inquired concerning a check for \$500 made out to William Allen White, editor of the Emporia, Kansas, Gazette in May, 1926. Marshall said this sum represented White's fee for his attendance at the Atlantic City convention at the invitation of the convention.

ZEPPELIN DIRIGIBLE ON SECOND TEST JOURNEY

FRIEDRICHSHAFEN, Germany, Sept. 20.—The dirigible Graf Zeppelin, in which Dr. Hugo Eckener intends to fly to America, ascended today for a second flight over southern Germany.

In addition to a crew of 39, the Graf Zeppelin carried 16 newspapers and 15 mechanics from the Friedrichshafen works.

Lieutenant Commander Charles E. Rosendahl, U. S. N., commander of the dirigible, Los Angeles, and John E. Kehl, American consul at Stuttgart, were also aboard.

CHRISTIANITY MUST BE WORLD-WIDE, DIVINE SAYS

(Associated Press Leased Wire) PORTLAND, Ore., Sept. 20.—A "near-sighted" Christianity which considers only America and is blind to the rest of the world will not have vision enough to lead America into larger and fuller life.

"There are great areas of American life to be Christianized, such as its politics, its industry, its race relations. The fundamental problem in the country today is that of living together, and that is the problem which Christianity is peculiarly fitted to deal or it ceases to be Christianity," said Dr. D'Merrill.

FARM REMINDERS

The best substitutes for green feed for poultry are alfalfa and clover hay, writes H. A. Schott, forage crop specialist at the Oregon experiment station in a new bulletin, "Green Feed and Pasture for Poultry." Kale is given as the best winter green feed where it can be produced.

Carbon tetrachloride has been found successful in treatment of sheep and goats infested with liver-flukes, a serious handicap to the industry in many parts of Oregon. Where breeders suspect their flocks are infested a small number are first treated and the effect observed.

Proper fertilization has been found to make crops less liable to unfavorable seasonal conditions. It is not a cure-all for every ill, however, as general soil management is essential in controlling moisture, the physical condition and chemical reaction and other factors.

Caponizing fowls by means of but one slit reduces the tendency to "wind puffs" which frequently result from this operation, reports W. T. Johnson, poultry pathologist at the Oregon station, in an
