NEW TEST SUBSTANTIATES MICHELSON LIGHT THEORY

PASADENA, Calif., Sept. 20.—The Michelson test of the speed of light have been adequately substantiated in new experiments just completed here, the discoverer himself Professor Albert A. Michelson of the University of Chicago has announced.

The speed of light was estimated by the Chicago physicist to be within a tulle per second of 186,284 miles per second.

The original Michelson theory of the speed of light generally has been recognized as the basis for the Einstein theory of relativity. About a year ago, other scientists reported tests which tended to contradict Michelson's experiments.

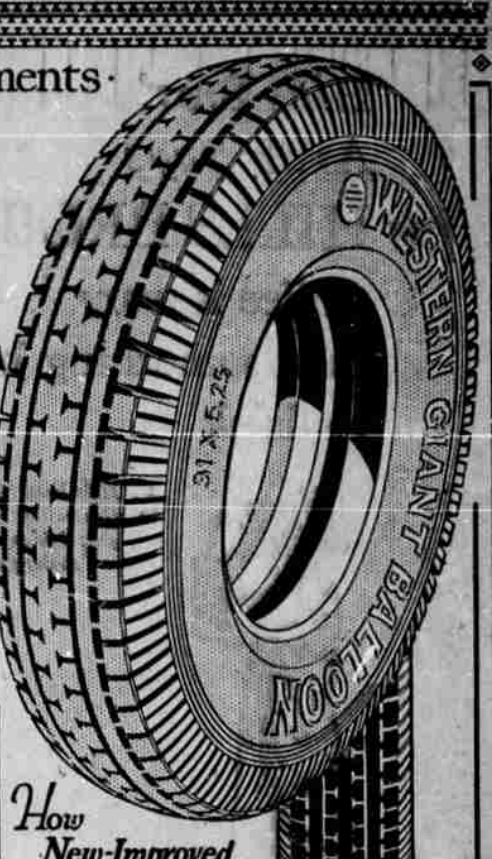

CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR IS ASKED TO FREE MOONEY

SACRAMENTO, Cal., Sept. 20.—A promise to review "with great care and an open mind" applications for pardon of Thomas J. Mooney, San Quentin life prisoner, was contained in a letter from Governor C. C. Young read by Paul Scharrrenberg, secretary of the California Federation of Labor at today's session of the state labor convention.

While the governor said that he "has never been able to bring himself to the belief" that Mooney was innocent of the preparedness day bombings in San Francisco in 1916, which resulted in the death of 19 persons, he said that he would devote the next several months to a review of the evidence.
