LARGE PER CENT CHILDREN HAVE DEFECTIVE TEETH

County Dental Survey Shows More Than 60 Per Cent in Need Dental Treatment.

Dr. Emil Brunk, who recently completed a dental survey in the schools of Douglas county, has filed his report with the county health association, showing that 64 per cent of the children in rural schools and 61 per cent of the children in the Roseburg schools have defective teeth.

Dr. Brunk examined 2,562 children in the rural schools and 2,205 in the city schools and in some of the districts found every child in the school to be in need of dental treatment.

In each examination a card was made showing the condition of the child's teeth and a report was made to the parents, recommending that the child be taken to the family dentist for treatment. It is hoped eventually to establish a county dental clinic in which dental services may be provided for the school children. It has been definitely proved that good teeth are necessary for health and that a child whose teeth are defective is apt to develop other defects of a more serious nature. On the presumption that prevention is better than cure, the health societies all over the country are giving more and more attention to the condition of school children's teeth in the hope of bettering general health conditions.
