PADELFORD AND JOE MARCUS TO FIGHT JAN. 30

Excellent Card Arranged by Promoter Wiard for Next Wednesday.

FIVE BOUTS SLATED

Heavyweights Will Appear in Semi Final—Riddle to Enter New Man in Preliminary.

Promoter Clyde Wiard has completed arrangements for the next fight card to be held Wednesday, January 30. The main event, as previously announced, is to be between Joe Marcus of Portland and Pat Riddle of Medford. Marcus is a well known boxer in this state. He is a main event fighter in Portland in the 135 pound class, and holds the Pacific coast junior lightweight title. He went to Australia last year and succeeded in winning the junior lightweight championship of that continent and also took the lightweight title. After cleaning up both of those classes he went into the light heavyweight division where he whipped some of Australia's best boxers in that group.

Marcus is a very popular boxer in and around Portland where he has been appearing frequently. He is an exceedingly fast boxer with a tremendous punching ability.

In meeting Marcus, Padelford gains an opportunity to step into the big money in the boxing game. Heretofore the former Roseburg boxer, now located at Medford, has been in the semi-final class. For a number of years he exhibited no inclination to take training seriously and as a result was beaten by a good number of second raters. During the last year, however, he has settled down to work and has been training regularly and consistently with the result that he has been topping over some of the best boxers of his class. Due to his showing this year he is considered the logical contender in the state for Marcus' crown. Padelford is a cagey fighter with a knockout punch in either hand. With the incentive that he has before him in the coming bout he is expected to make a real showing.

The semi-final is to be a six-round heavyweight battle between Young Jess Willard, 207 pounds, of Libby, Montana, and Pat Gorman, of Albany, 200 pounds.

The special event will be a four-round affair between "Tiger" Dunn of Riddle and Edgar James of Roseburg. Dunn and James both won fights by knockouts on the last card. Dunn has had only three fights and James only two, but both have exhibited exceptional hitting ability. It is believed that they are quite evenly matched and

will be able to show fans an exciting encounter.

The town of Riddle, that produced Dunn, who has risen to rapid popularity with local fans, is also offering another fighter in the preliminary on the coming card, which from appearances will equal the other bouts for excitement. Frank Hamlin, of Riddle, is to be matched against young Pendergrass of Roseburg in a four-round preliminary bout. Hamlin is a relative and pupil of Ed Hamlin, who for many years was considered one of Oregon's best boxers and was well known locally. Pendergrass has appeared on several local cards and has shown himself to be a fast and clever boy with a wicked wallop. He recently came from Portland where he fought his way up to the semi-finals in the amateur elimination match. The Portland boy who beat him there won the Portland championship.

Mr. Wiard is also working on arrangements for a curtain raiser, but has nothing definite at present to announce regarding this possible match. The five bouts that he has already listed are sufficient to give fans another excellent card and one that should attract much attention.

The card is to be one of the most expensive ever staged in Roseburg, as the cost of bringing Marcus here from Portland is the heaviest obligation ever assumed by a local promoter, so that Mr. Wiard is very anxiously hoping for a good attendance, which he is justified in expecting by the class of the entertainment offered.

CROOK'S LIBERTY ON HABEAS CORPUS WRIT VERY BRIEF

(Associated Press Local Wire)

SALT LAKE CITY, Jan. 23.—One hundred Alabama jail breakers were in custody here today after an unsuccessful effort to gain his freedom on a writ of habeas corpus. Another had escaped arrest. The prisoner is identified as Roy Dickerson, who with Frank Cook, convicted of burglary, and Ivanhoe Silva, known as Birmingham's "bootlegger king," escaped from the Kilby prison in Alabama last October.

Dickerson, who first gave his name as Edward P. Allen, was arrested here Monday night on suspicion of planning a burglary on a downtown department store. A man in an automobile with him and who escaped was identified by police as Cook.

Dickerson was granted his freedom here yesterday on a writ of habeas corpus only to be rearrested by federal officers on a charge that the car he was driving had been stolen in California. Two fugitive complaints also were filed against him.

Police declared Dickerson had confessed while under arrest in Seattle sometime ago, to the \$9,000 burglary of a department store here two years ago.

Conservation was caused at the police station here last night when a tear gas gun taken from Dickerson, and which looked like a fountain pen, exploded in the hands of an officer. He was not injured.

SECOND AND WORSE FLU WAVE FEARED

Crest of First Wave of Epidemic Believed to Have Been Reached in West.

Health authorities fear that the present decline in the number of new flu cases may be only a prelude to a second and more severe wave.

They point out the importance of keeping free from colds, especially if the system has already been weakened by the flu, as colds at this time are so apt to bring on bronchitis, pneumonia, or a second flu attack.
