

KOTSONAROS PINS CLETE KAUFFMAN IN ROUGH MATCH

PORTLAND, Ore., Jan. 31.—When Clete Kauffman of Connecticut, O., elected to teach it with George Kotsonaros, Hollywood weather-movie actor, in their match here last night, he found Kotsonaros perfectly willing and as a result Kotsonaros took two straight falls from the Orlan. The first fall followed a succession of jolting reverse headlocks under the chin which sent Kauffman spinning dizzily to the mat. As he asked himself up from the third of these, Kotsonaros grabbed him with both hands by the head, swung him like a sack of grain over his own head and shoulders, then fell backwards on top of him. After they carried Kauffman to the dressing room and worked over him 15 minutes he came back, but it only required 10 seconds for Kotsonaros to finish him with almost a repetition of the first fall, which required 45 minutes, 21 seconds.

PORTLAND BANK WINS SUIT OVER EXPENSE ACCOUNT

SAN FRANCISCO, Jan. 30.—The United States circuit court today held that the Nassau company formerly Ladd & Tilton bank of Portland, is not liable for ex-

penses incurred by two federal investigators outside the state of Oregon during the investigation of the failure of the bank at Jacksonville in September, 1929.

The Oregon courts held the bank was responsible for all expenses incurred by investigators sent to Oregon from the East by the United States.

The Ladd & Tilton bank was involved in litigation with the Jacksonville institution over gold notes alleged to have been forged by William Johnson, president and cashier of the insolvent bank.

STUDY PHEASANTS

Study of the habits of the Hungarian partridge by men in charge of the state game commission's three game farms has proven interesting. When a pair of the little birds decide to mate up they meet it as a rule and a "divorce" is almost unknown. European authorities claim that the Hungarian mate for life, but Gene Simpson, superintendent of the game farms, says that he has known several cases where this has proven untrue. Early each year all the Hungarian partridges on each farm are placed together. The females look over the males and choose one as a mate. When mated each pair is put in a separate pen. A male is as diligent about settling on the eggs as the female and rears the brood in case of death on the part of his mate.

MARCUS VICTOR IN TENTH OVER PAT PADELFORD

Finishing Punch, Declared
Foul, Draws Protesting
Roar From Crowd.

TOWEL GOES IN RING

Portlander Master of the
Bout After 3rd Round;
Hamlin-Pendergrass
Fight Thriller.

To the accompaniment of an uproar from nearly eight hundred spectators—the largest crowd ever to witness a boxing event in this city—over claims of a foul blow, Pat Padelford, Medford lightweight, went down to defeat before Joe Marcus Victor, Portland, junior welterweight, in the tenth round of the main event at the Roseburg armory last night. The final blow of the battle, a left swing by the Portlander, which stretched Padelford face down on the canvas, appeared to many spectators to have landed in foul territory and a terrific clamor arose. Referee Cal Herman started to toll off the count, but before he could reach the tenth round, a former protest by registered with the judges, a towel from the prostrate batter's corner fluttered into the ring as a concession of defeat and the decision was promptly awarded to Marcus. During the roar of dissatisfaction that shook the building, the two fighters clasped hands in cordial fashion and the argument was all over so far as they were concerned. Padelford's weight was announced as 131 and Marcus as 134.

The noisy finale from the ring-side was in reality the climax of a series of outbursts that began during the seventh round when Marcus, who had piled up a big lead by clever work and never-ending aggressiveness, sent Padelford down for the first time, with a stomach punch of questionable fairness. Pat took the count of five and then weathered Marcus' succeeding barrage until the zone changed. In the eighth round Padelford was floored three times, the last time with what was claimed to be a knee jolt in the groin. During the roar of protest that came from the spectators, Referee Herman, after Pat arose at the count of seven, asked both fighters to their corners and the bell formally closed the round several seconds later. In the ninth round Pat was piled up in the ropes and stayed there for the count of nine. During the remainder of the round he was driven all around the ring but managed to keep his feet. With seemingly regained strength, Padelford attempted to rally in the last round but in the second exchange of blows he received the swing that laid him low.

It was clearly Marcus' fight from the fourth round. Pat's left hook to the body and right cross to the jaw, with which he has won his previous fights, proved useless against the experienced and shifty Portlander, who bored in constantly and was nearly always first with faster punches. Pat made his best showing in the first round when he opened a slash over Marcus' left eye. He held the Portlander even in the second and third rounds, but after that he began losing ground before a superior batter and the result seemed never in doubt.

Preliminary Hard Fought
Richly charting first honors with the main event so far as action was concerned was a four-round preliminary between Austin Pendergrass, a 17-year-old Roseburg lad, weighing about 125 pounds, and Frank Hamlin of Riddle, nearly twice the boy's age and weight, weighing around 135. There were six knockdowns during the battle, only one of which, the first, was received by Hamlin. He was up at the count of two and floored Pendergrass three times before the bell rang. Pendergrass received his fourth knockdown in the second round and the fifth knockdown in the third. In spite of this punishment, the boy never stopped boxing and registered some stiff punches. A great rally by Pendergrass in the fourth round erased the big margin Hamlin had piled up earlier and resulted in a draw decision. The blood-soaked fighters cupped their faces and the crowd cheered for the verdict and the referee's approval. The battle was one of the hardest fought in a local ring. Lusty cheers went to the boy and repeated salvos of boos to his older and heavier antagonist, who, however, fought cleanly from start to finish.

Dunn Wins His Fourth
"Tiger" Dunn of Riddle registered his fourth straight victory and third successive knockout in a local ring in another of the preliminaries, the victim being Edgar James of this city. James took the count of ten at the end of one minute and a half in the second round. It was James' second indication of the canvas, the first occurring in the opening round, when he took after Dunn in a striking posture. Dunn bore no marks of punishment at the close.

A four-round curtain raiser between local boys, Pat Franco and Hal Stayers, resulted in a draw.

The scheduled six-round semi-final between two outside heavyweights, failed to materialize be-

cause one of them, Pat Gorman, failed to show up. The number on the program was filled by a fast four-round exhibition bout between Eddie Cartwright, negro middleweight, and Jackie Nash a lightweight, both of Portland. Both men are to fight tomorrow night on a card at Marshfield. Cartwright takes on Willard Norton of Eugene in the main event and Nash will clash with Pat Padelford in the semi-final.
