GUSHER BLOW-IN INJURES 8 MEN

SANTA BARBARA, Calif., Mar. 8.—A test well of the Continental Oil company blew in 12 miles east of here yesterday, injuring eight oil workers. The new gusher spouted in a virgin field.

Reports here said the gusher was "blowing wild" and throwing a column of gas and oil high in the air. No fire danger was imminent, reports said. Control of the well was expected within several hours.

The well came in near Carpinteria, Calif. The field never had been drilled before, it was understood, and oil men viewed the gusher as opening a new territory.

NOTICE FOR BIDS FOR AVIATION PARK BONDS

Notice is hereby given, that the undersigned will, up to 7:30 P. M., on Monday, the 18th day of March, 1929, at his office in the City Hall in the City of Roseburg, Oregon, receive sealed proposals for the purchase of Aviation Park Bonds in the sum of \$25,000.00.

Said bonds are issued under authority of the Charter of the City of Roseburg and Ordinance No. 924, as amended by Ordinance No. 924, duly and regularly passed by the Common Council of the City of Roseburg, Oregon, and approved by the Mayor of said City March 5th, 1929, for the purpose of providing funds for the acquisition and maintenance of an aviation park and field as described in Ordinance No. 920. The bonds are in denominations of \$500.00 each, and bear interest at the rate of five per cent, per annum, payable semi-annually, and are dated March 1st, 1929, and are payable serially one tenth (1/10) each year, the first payment being payable one year from the date of issue.

No bid for less than par and accrued interest will be accepted, and the Council reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Each bid must be by a certified check or draft for the sum of \$500.00 payable to the City of Roseburg, to be forfeited to the City in case the successful bidder shall fail to complete the purchase.
