(Continued from page 1) repairs, Cass street one hundred square yards, and Jackson street one hundred square yards.

There are also about ten or twelve blocks which should be re-surfaced as soon as possible and two or three blocks that must be re-surfaced this summer.

In addition a number of holes have been cut in the pavement by the power company for the purpose of repairing its pipes and these holes will have to be re-surfaced.

The members of the council went over the streets and verified the report of the city engineer and Mr. Frew.

It is not the intention nor the desire of the council to make any unnecessary repairs to the streets, neither will it do so, but we feel it our duty to keep the present pavement in necessary repair.

Unfortunatly, our paved streets have not been constructed for the heavy traffic of today and are beginning to give away in places and repairs should be made promptly upon indication of their breaking through.

was of the opinion that it should not be done until the fall had settled. That work, however, would have stood up a great deal better if it had been rolled with the roller having the weight of the machine which the council proposes to purchase.

The experience of the city of Roseburg in purchasing second-hand equipment has not been satisfactory and we deem it advisable to purchase new equipment. The present pavements especially in the business district have been in place for a great number of years and will constantly be requiring repairs.

In addition, it will be necessary to use a roller extensively on the aeroplane field. This roller which the council proposes to purchase can be used on that work at a great saving both to the city and to the airport committee.

It has been suggested that the second-hand steam roller owned by Mr. Metzger should have been purchased, but we have investigated this roller and do not believe that it would be economical to purchase or lease the same.

The roller which the council proposes to purchase for the city is manufactured by a reliable concern and is standard equipment used by the state and counties and cities.

The city charter makes it the duty and it is entirely within the power of the council to provide for the cleaning and repairing of the streets.

The members of the council, of course, are well aware of the fact that they can function as a council only when assembled in a regular or special meeting and have always contemplated taking such action as might be necessary to legalize the purchase of the roller.

The council carefully investigated both the necessity of the purchase of the roller and its cost. At present the city has a five hundred pound roller which is operated by hand.

The work done by Mr. Frew and his men has been very satisfactory and economical. Practically the only piece of work which has not been satisfactory was the work on Stephens street caused by the excavation of the power company.

This work was done in the late fall and was done contrary to the recommendation of Mr. Frew, who
