Williams was forced to abandon efforts yesterday when the terrific speed at which he was traveling forced the pure air from the small compartment which he practically had to lie down in to man the ship, and gases from the 24 cylinder motor forced their way in and overcame him.

The navy's air speed ace said that when he felt dizziness over-coming him, he almost automatically cut the switches on the motor, and the little torpedo-like monoplane came to a halt, and he was aided from the cockpit.

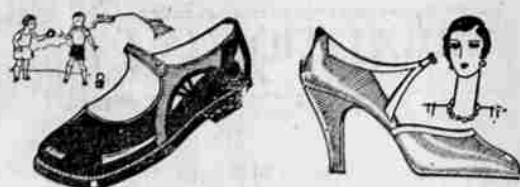

CHINA BRACED FOR ATTACK BY SOVIET FORCES

pute between Russia and China, the Russian radio station at Khabarovsk has daily broadcast news and propaganda about the Chinese Eastern railway situation.

Mukden has taken the hint and is using its radio station for similar purposes.

Adherence to the facts of the dispute does not appear to be the guiding principle of these rival stations.

It was an officially broadcast announcement from Mukden which reported the mythical invasion of Manchuria by 10,000 Russian troops August 17, while Khabarovsk's latest effort is a denunciation of the American department of state for "plotting with the French government to set up an international control commission for the Chinese Eastern railway in order to have a finger in the pie."

The Russian station added that "the stubborn and crafty Japan is standing by to protect and improve her Manchurian interests."

World Revolt Began
WASHINGTON, Aug. 22.—Russian Soviet authorities are accused of activities to "bring about a world-wide revolution" in the latest Chinese note dealing with the Manchurian controversy.

The Nanking officials found evidence, they said, that the Russians were promoting "secret plans to

nullify China's unification, to overthrow the Chinese government, to organize secret forces for destroying the Chinese Eastern railway, and to carry out a policy of wholesale assassinations and thereby bring about a world wide revolution."
