TODAY'S MARKETS

Wool Situation
DOSTON, Oct. 25.—The Commercial Bulletin today says:
There has been a fair activity in this week in the finer territory, but the market has held firm on the basis of the advance noted last week end or close to five cents a pound, clean, from the extreme low point.
Foreign markets have held very firm both in the primary markets and the secondary markets of Europe even in the face of an apparent serious strike in Yorkshire mills.
The manufacturing position in this country is essentially sound and the manner in which mills have bought wool this week has been the best evidence of that fact.
"Mother is slow here but the fall clip of the southwest is pretty well cleared from the market, the accumulation bringing 45¢ cents for the adult hair, while interior stocks were sold at 42¢, with ten cents additional from kid hair."

Pilchard Market Buoys
OREGON STATE COLLEGE, Corvallis, Oct. 25.—Oregon Pilchards are meeting such a ready market that present supplies of members are insufficient to meet the orders placed with the North Pacific Net Growers cooperative. W. H. Bentley, manager, has notified the local co-operative service. He has asked co-operation in getting word to independent growers that a profitable market exists for all first class supplies this year through the co-operative organization.
Not only is the Pilchard market active and much stronger than it has been for the last two seasons, but our own markets are much broader than ever before," said Mr. Bentley. "We want to be able to give as nearly 100 per cent delivery as possible, as it is a great opening wedge to the sale of much greater tonnage in the future."
The association will this year make the first shipments of full car lots of Pilchards to the Atlantic seaboard markets.
