TODAY'S MARKETS

(Associated Press Local Wire)

PORTLAND, Ore., Nov. 26.—Egg prices are still soaring, with the fresh variety showing the most fluctuations given out today by the Pacific Cooperative Poultry Producers show advance of two cents in fresh extra large, three cents in standard, one cent in fresh mediums and two cents on fresh pullets. These were the prices to wholesalers. The prices to retailers were usually two cents additional.

Butter prices were steady at the Portland Produce Exchange.

Reviewing the fruit and vegetable situation, the Portland market news bureau of the United States department of agriculture says:

Another day of heavy apple receipts by motor truck was registered at the wholesale fruit and vegetable market today, with nearly 2,000 boxes trucked in from nearby districts. Much of this stock is graded for storage, and the market is in a state of confusion between now and New Year.

Citrus fruit is sharply higher, in the earliest shipping stage, and this condition is reflected in higher prices for sales on good cauliflower, locally. Number 2 quality continues rather cheap, however.

Completed Concord grapes have about completed their movement to market. Rumpuses and Tuleys from southern Oregon are arriving in fair volume and present an extremely attractive appearance.

Sweet potatoes are moving into market slowly, and the marketing market is drab, holding barely steady at 4 1/2 to 5 1/2 per 10.
