

OLD PROSPECTORS FINDING PAY ORE

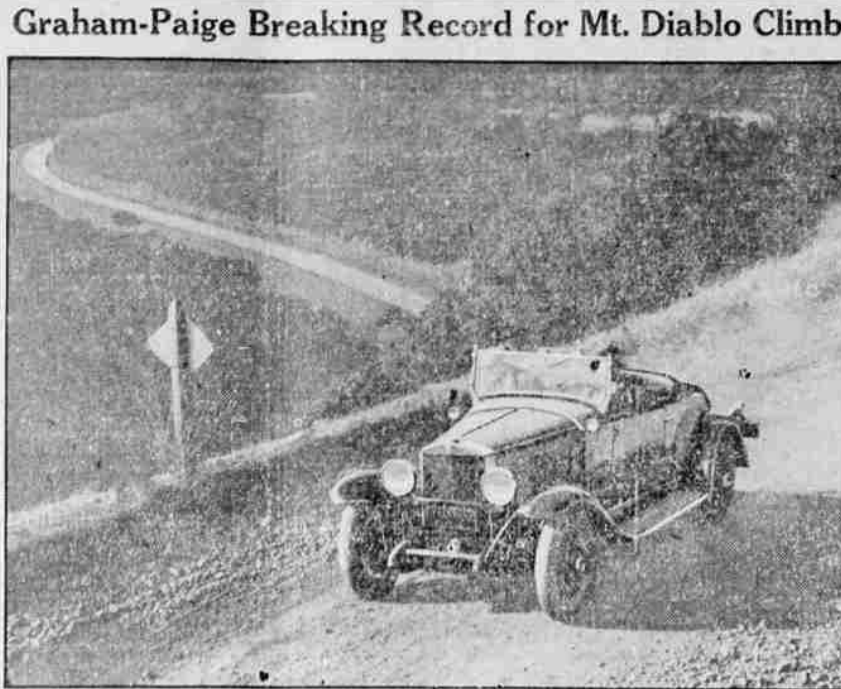
