Physicians declared he will be able to return to the gridiron next season, but he is out for the remainder of this season. Kitzmiller had planned to turn out for basketball this winter, but his injury, which he sustained by the corner of a machine last year, has injured him and he will not play basketball.

Although there is no one who can adequately fill the hole at quarterback, Kitzmiller's substitute in the Hawaii game probably will be Johnny Lundell, his understudy. Lundell replaced Kitzmiller last Saturday and turned in a brilliant performance.

## KITZMILLER WILL NOT BE CRIPPLED, PHYSICIANS SAY

EUGENE, Ore., Nov. 18.—Johnny Kitzmiller, quarterback and famed "Flying Dutchman" of the University of Oregon football team, will not be permanently crippled by the ankle injury he received in the Oregon-O. S. C. game Saturday, in the opinion of Dr. Richard Dillehunt, dean of the University medical school in Portland. Dean Dillehunt came to Eugene today to examine Kitzmiller. Doctors Miller and Riddle of the university department corroborated the dean's opinion.

The doctors said the injury will keep Kitzmiller out of the lineup for the remainder of the season but that the injury would leave the "Flying Dutchman" unimpaired when the ankle knits.

Kitzmiller is in the Eugene hospital surrounded by books and flowers. He said today that hard tackling was responsible for his injury and that he had no thought of malice on the part of rival tacklers.

## WORLD WAR VETS ADVISED TO APPLY UNDER NEW PLAN

December 31, 1929, is the final date on which World War veterans may apply for adjusted compensation. Uniqua Post No. 16, American Legion, desires and requests every man or woman in Douglas county, who is eligible, to apply at once if you have not already done so. Any person who served in the armed forces of the United States during the World War is entitled to adjusted compensation. Briefly, the adjusted compensation is a 20-year annuity of this policy is based upon the time spent in service during the World War. Full details will be furnished anyone interested by Roy O. Young, service officer of Uniqua post. There is no expense for this service or for making application. The great majority of veterans have received their certificates but, according to word received from Washington, there are still a large number entitled to apply who have not done so. Parents or dependents of deceased veterans who did not receive a certificate are also entitled to adjusted compensation. Through the efforts of the American Legion the time for apply was extended from Dec. 31, 1927 to Dec. 31, 1929. Without doubt there will be no further extension of time to apply. It is requested that applications be filed as soon as possible.

## W. O. W. ENJOINED FROM OPERATING "OLD LINE" RATES

DENVER, Colo., Nov. 18.—The Women of the World lodge, with headquarters in Denver, yesterday was enjoined by order of the district court from putting into operation an "old line" system of insurance. Judge George F. Dunklee, in handing down his decision, held illegal and void certain constitutional amendments adopted at a meeting in Oakland, Cal., last summer, substituting an old line system for the fraternal policy of the order.

Judge Dunklee directed attorneys to prepare a draft of the decision. He set November 25 as the time for hearing objections, giving the society time to appeal from the decision.

The W. O. W. operates in Colorado, California, Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, Oregon, Utah, Washington and Wyoming. The society is incorporated under Colorado laws and has its main offices in Denver.
