PORTLAND, Ore., Jan. 21.—Cold weather so far has failed to bring any further advances in egg and butter quotations. Eggs have been at their present price for more than a week and butter has not advanced since the middle of last week. Prices were steady today without change.
Receiving in fruit and vegetable situation in Portland bureau of the United States department of agriculture says:
"Cash trading continued light on the wholesale market, but delivery business continues brisk. Apples, etc., still firm, as a result of Saturday's additional snowfall.
"Several orders of southern produce are on track, suspended on account of being incalculable, one to dried fruits and vegetables remain about unchanged in price.
"Local conditions advanced again, to 2 1/2c per lb. to retailers, for best choice California raisins, moving slowly at present rather high prices; green peas from Mexico were introduced slightly to market, competition, and lettuce prices are firm, both at Portland and at Imperial valley shipping points.
