Billions Can Be Saved WASHINGTON, Jan. 21.—In the event the London naval conference fails to reach agreement, an expenditure of \$2,000,000,000 by the United States for warship construction during the next 15 years was forecast in the house yesterday by Representative French, republican, Idaho, chairman of the appropriations sub-committee in charge of naval expenditures.

French declared for scrapping of the battleships of the navies of the world.
