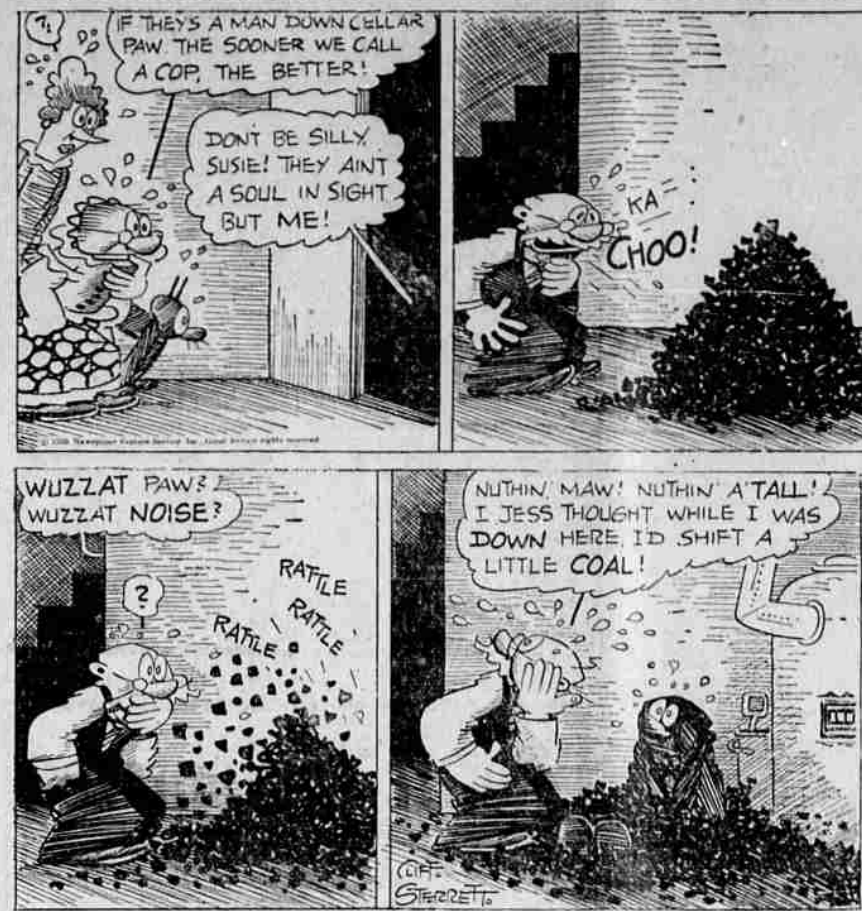

EUGENE, Ore., Feb. 28—Dr. Arnold Bennett Hall, president of the University of Oregon, has been appointed trustee of Lincoln university, an institution to be established in Westchester county, New York. The new school will be limited to 1200 students and will have an endowment of \$75,000,000, the largest of any endowed university in the country.

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
