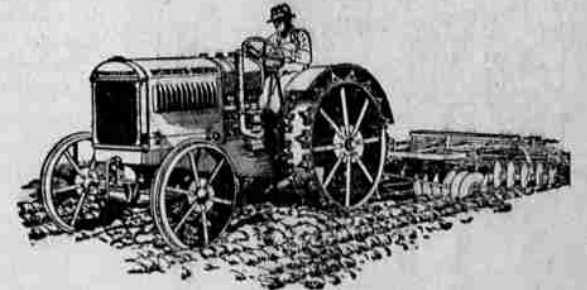

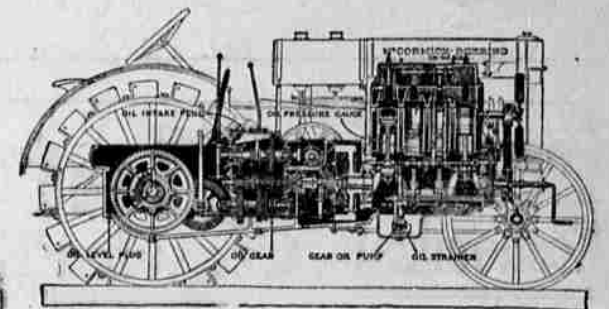

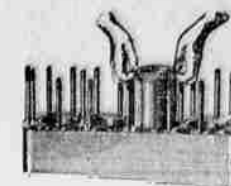
Such practice also uses a minimum of labor—one man generally operating both the tractor and machine.

Note the many superior features of construction that are indicated by the various arrows. Every feature found on McCormick-Deering tractors has withstood the test of time and practical service. As a result, McCormick-Deering construction stands for performance, economy and long life.



The cylinders are cast separately of close-grained gray iron. They are fitted into the engine housing as shown left. Being cast separately they can be made of harder material which takes a very high polish and thus adds to the wearing qualities. This construction also permits the cylinder walls to be of more uniform thickness, which aids in cooling and lubrication.

This higher polish reduces compression losses to a minimum. Should a cylinder become scored or worn after long use a new one can be installed with little loss of time at a fractional part of the cost of re-boring or replacing an entire cylinder block. New cylinders make practically a new engine.
