Harry L. Corbett was born in Oregon in July 1881, over 48 years ago. He is married and has five children. His people are among Oregon's early pioneers.

He has served four sessions in the State Senate, was president of that body in 1927, and has twice been acting Governor of Oregon in the absence of the late Governor Patterson from the state.
