TODAY'S MARKETS

(Associated Press Local Wire)
PORTLAND, June 27.—Butter and egg quotations remained unchanged on the Portland wholesale market today. Demand was fair for both. Butter receipts were cleared well. Egg receipts were liberal, part going to storage.
Quotations and demand for country dressed meats and poultry continued steady with Thursday conditions.
The Sherry Flour company announced a price reduction on flour. Watermelons continue their very heavy daily movement of 150 cars. With night, although prices are low enough—\$15 per ton at southern California shipping points, and 2½¢ per lb. to Portland retailers. Arizona cantaloupes movement is in full swing now with daily shipments in excess of 100 carloads. Quality is reported very good. Portland's first arrivals are expected in a few days.
Hothouse tomatoes are moving slowly, due to plentiful supplies of good quality. Cucumber, hothouse cucumbers continue in fairly good demand, as supplies are only moderate, and outdoor cucumbers are not an important factor yet.
There were virtually no strawberries on the east Alder street market today, to the first time in several weeks. Quality is poor now, although suitable for barrelling, after careful regrading.
Brooks' grocery stores have been distributing the equivalent of about one carload daily for the past two weeks, by motor truck and mixed-car shipments via Portland. First straight car shipments were made this week to northwestern points.

YAKIMA, Wash., June 27.—Due to widespread crop failure in Oregon, western Washington and British Columbia, complete reversal in the hop market has occurred in the Yakima valley almost overnight.
With prices having jumped five cents, active trading is being carried on at from 12 to 16 cents a pound. Four growers were said to control the remaining 1400 bales of the 1929 production. This year's crop estimates were placed at 15,000 bales in comparison to 23,000 last year.
