

HAWLEY ISSUES REPLY TO CRITICS OF TARIFF BILL

NEW YORK, July 2.—William C. Hawley, chairman of the Ways and Means committee of the house and co-sponsor of the Hawley-Smoot tariff, has joined the administration's "big gun" defenders of the new duties by attacking those critics who declare the law will cripple American foreign trade.

It will do nothing of the sort, he says. Instead, an increase in imports may be expected.

His tariff views are set forth in an article in the current Review of Reviews in which he declares there is no truth in the criticism that the law establishes the highest rates in history.

Prophecy increased imports, Mr. Hawley says:

"When the Dingley act replaced the Wilson act, the annual average imports increased from \$740,000,000 to \$998,000,000, or 31 per cent. Likewise the average increased under the Fordney-McCumber act, which superseded the Underwood act, from \$2,871,000,000 to \$4,052,000,000, or 41 per cent. History will undoubtedly repeat itself."

The weighted average ad valorem on dutiable imports were 48.39

per cent under the McKinley tariff and 46.49 per cent under the Dingley act Mr. Hawley says, and under the new tariff the average is 41.22. That is his reply to critics who declare the new law imposes the tallest taxes ever.

"The bill," he declares, "is lower than the average under republican protection."

The congressman denies that consumers will suffer heavily from the new law.

"There is," he says, "neither historical nor economical justification for the wild statements that the duties will cost consumers great sums. Such statements are issued to prejudice the legislation in the public mind, but without regard to economic facts."

METHODIST UNION BEING DISCUSSED

PITTSBURGH, July 1.—Discussion of a basis for merging the Methodist Protestant church with the Methodist Episcopal church, north, began here today at a meeting of a commission of the Methodist Protestant church.

The commission will meet tomorrow with a similar body representing the Methodist Episcopal church to continue the discussion.

The sessions are looked upon as a step toward union of all Methodism. If the merger were effected, 200,000 Methodist Protestants and 5,250,000 Methodist Episcopalians would be joined as one denomination.

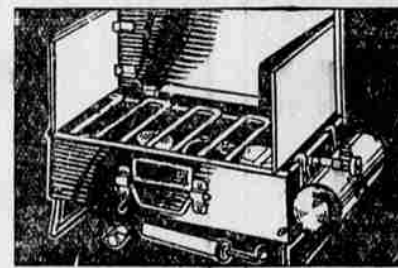
