ALIEN COMMERCE, RELIGION FOUGHT BY CHINESE REDS

SHANGHAI, July 10.—American, British and Japanese river patrol boats joined today in defensive operations as bandits and communists intensified their firing on foreign vessels in the Yangtze and flaunted a banner reading "down with imperialism, capitalism, foreigners and religion!"
Marauders continued to fire heavily at all foreign commercial or navy craft operating along Kiang and particularly beyond Hankow, where steamers attempting to reach the lower river were reported to have been subjected to showers of bullets from both banks.
Commanders of the American, Japanese and British patrol boats were understood to be working co-operatively regarding distribution of their ships, each patrol attempting to protect all foreigners regardless of nationality.
Because of the large number of places in which gunboats were needed, the number under any one flag was inadequate.
Reliable reports said the bandits were well armed with rifles and machine guns and had plundered numerous small river ports between Hankow and Ichang, obtaining considerable money from post offices and customs houses and abducting anyone worth a ransom.
Shipping along Hankow virtually ceased. Business was interrupted as merchants fled. Since the bandit raid on Yochow American gunboats have rescued four Spanish Catholic priests who were in hiding there.
River bandits were said to be making special efforts to abduct foreigners. Missionaries and other foreigners in the interior were believed to be in danger. American consular authorities were instructed to repeat warnings to

any of their nationals in those areas and to urge them to evacuate.
