CALIFORNIA continues to furnish by far the largest number of families in the list of states from which new residents come to Oregon, according to the monthly report just issued by W. G. Fife, state chamber of commerce. Fifteen California families were reported to have arrived and bought farms the last week in June. The report shows a total of 297 families who arrived during the last six months of this year, who have purchased over 50,000 acres of land and invested in lands, household goods, machinery and equipment of all kinds approximately \$1,282,384.

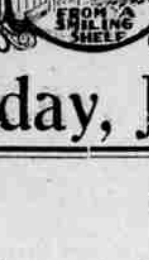
