Tragedy Takes Its Toll

BECAUSE it is only three short hours to the scene of the tragic shooting Thursday night of four officers of the law; because these officers were known to many in this vicinity and because of its sensational features we residents of Roseburg and Douglas county today stand against while possess hunt this fiendish Marcola killer. Somehow an event of this kind brings home the realization of just how weak we law abiding folks are. Somehow it seems so unjust that one depraved man can take the lives of two honest officers and seriously wound two others. Even if he is captured alive, which is doubtful; even if he is hanged, which is probable if he is caught, his life cannot begin to pay for those of the two good men whom he killed in cold blood. He deserves the strictest punishment the law provides.

It takes an event of this kind to awaken us to the stern fact that after all our civilization is only skin-deep—that among our numbers are potential murderers. With all our efforts to make the world a better place in which to live we are led to wonder just how much we have actually accomplished. Behind this case looms the grotesque figure of moonshine liquor. The lives of two men have been laid down because one criminal would not observe the law. We cannot blame this on prohibition. This man would have killed had his offense been anything else in the whole category of crime. We never know as we go along our way just who may turn out to be the robber, the killer, the highwayman. It is not a hopeful situation nor an encouraging tribute to our so-called civilization.

Yesterday's papers (just as those of almost any other days) were filled with stories of tragedy. War, death, desolation, failure, matricide, suicide, kidnapping, bombings, accidental deaths, automobile and airplane fatalities! It is due time to pause and ask ourselves: "Whither are we drifting?" Despite it all the old axiom that "hope springs eternal in the human breast" is still true. We view the horrid conditions which prevail today ever hopeful that tomorrow will bring a new order of things. It is as it should be. Let us continue to hope that the future will bring a new and better standard of living throughout our whole land.—G. C. R.

Canada Retaliates

THE Rogue River Traffic association has asked the Oregon congressional delegation to take immediate action on the Canadian tariff rate increase on pears and apples.
 The apple rate was increased from 25 cents a box to 40 cents and pears from 20 cents a box to 32 cents. Similar steps are to be taken by grocers and shippers' organizations in California and Washington.
 What grounds exist for Americans to protest the Canadian tariff? It is merely one of the numerous reprisal measures foreign governments are taking as a result of the increased tariff of foreign products imposed by the Hawley-Smoot tariff and Canada, along with 35 other foreign nations filed official protests against the Hawley-Smoot schedule barring her products and the protests were ignored and flouted by congress and president.
 Canada and other foreign governments are within their rights in imposing whatever duties on imports deemed desirable and are merely following the example set for many years by the United States with those of other states. America cannot penalize other countries without suffering penalties in reprisal. What is sauce for the goose is sauce for the gander. We reap as we have sown.
 The Hawley-Smoot tariff is reacting as all economic experts predicted by closing foreign markets to American products and diminishing our imports along with our exports. The growers of Oregon, along with those of other states are paying for Mr. Hawley's experiment in statesmanship. During the first 50 days of the new tariff, customs receipts have fallen off from \$55,000,000 to about \$45,000,000 and the foreign markets for our surplus are being lost—and it was these markets that

created our post-war prosperity.—Salem Journal.

Significance of Labor Day

The most significant feature of the industrial world today is the passionate cry for social justice. Right and equity are scorned by the rank and file of men in industry in our day. They insist that equity, not charity, is the only adequate basis for industrial relationships. Charity at its best is palliative; it fosters dependence and fails to create free and efficient men.

What the whole artisan class is discussing today is not justification, but justice.

Any religion that would meet the outstanding demand of the modern industrial world must be based on the ideal of social justice; and any gospel that would heal the hurt of the men of industry must be saturated with the spirit of social justice. From the Christian point of view the primary question in industry today is this: Shall the symbol of our American industrial life be the dollar mark or the cross? The answer to this question will determine the character and the quality of modern industry.

Labor day offers us another opportunity to prove again to ourselves and to all the world that the American heart is still stronger than the American dollar, that industry in America is a means to an end, and that the creation and propagation of men who are wise enough to rule and good enough to be trusted—the only adequate foundation for democracy in industry.—McMinnville Telephone-Register.

Anti-War Arguments

Since the close of the civil war there has been paid a total of \$7,370,462,914 in pensions to veterans and their widows; the war itself cost \$5,000,000,000. And the pension cost of that war is not over; there are still 45,213 pensioned survivors of that campaign and 166,532 civil war widows still under pension.

Ten widows of the war of 1812 and 221 widows of the Mexican war are still receiving pensions, and pension payments to Spanish-American war veterans reached a total of \$470,498,752 on July 1st of this year.
 Statistics of this sort make the most effective anti-war propaganda. In a period of full nationalism the world will admit that all war is folly because it rarely ever settles anything, takes a tremendous toll in lives and property, and imposes a financial burden on the countries involved for a century after peace is declared.

Pension costs do not argue against pensions, but against the war that makes pensions necessary and just. This was stressed at the recent convention of the United Spanish War Veterans in Philadelphia as an argument for world abolition of war.—LaGrande Observer.

WIGFALL'S STOLEN WILL STILL SOUGHT

 PORTLAND, Aug. 29.—Not content with the coroner's jury verdict of suicide in the mysterious death of Charles Y. Wigfall, 35, eccentric Portland attorney and former Vancouver, Wash., mine detective today hored deeper into the maze of evidence brought forth by their investigation.
 After the jury last night decided Wigfall ended his own life, detectives said they had not discovered Wigfall's original will, reported by Judge W. W. McCredie, his law partner, and former Portland baseball club owner, as having been stolen.
 Regardless of how authorities decide Wigfall met his death, the \$50,000 insurance policy the attorney held is payable to Mrs. W. W. McCredie, the judge's wife, whom Wigfall named as beneficiary. Two other policies, one for \$10,000 and another for \$5,000, are accident policies and are not payable in case of suicide, authorities said.

4 TRAINMEN BLAMED FOR S. P. COLLISION

 SAN LUIS OBISPO, Cal., Aug. 29.—Four members of the crews of the Southern Pacific crack trains, Lack and Padre, were blamed by a board of inquiry here today for the rear end collision Thursday in which 25 persons were injured.
 The four men blamed were W. E. Smith and V. L. Covington, engineer and conductor of the Lack and J. McNabb and L. W. Leeman, conductor and flagman of the Padre.
 Covington and Smith were blamed for bringing the Padre into the yards ahead of time and for exceeding the 15 mile an hour rule. McNabb and Leeman were found at fault for not predicting the rear of the Padre according to rules.

GRANGE OFFICIAL MOVES TO ROSEBURG

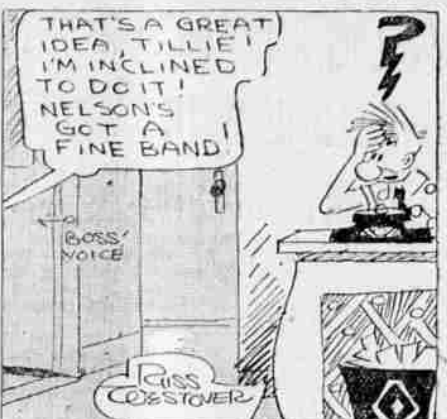
