TODAY'S MARKETS

(Associated Press Local Wire)

PORTLAND, Aug. 29.—A 10c advance of the price of sugar by refiners has affected the Portland wholesale market. Prices today were somewhat mixed.

Some dealers quoted cane sugar at 44.70 per cwt. effective today and in some cases not till Tuesday. At least one dealer was asking 44.80. Beet sugar was given a like rise to sell at the less than cane sugar.

Portland wholesale butter market prices were held unchanged and reported more liberal. Receivers were reported inclined to hold back on fresh supplies in anticipation of higher prices in prospect with outside markets already higher.

Egg quotations were steady with Pacific with receipts and demand normal. Some storage withdrawals were made.

Review of outstanding conditions in the wholesale fruit and vegetable market was quiet today, due to retailers' unwillingness to be caught buying over-supplies on the Labor-day holiday.

Lemons declined again to 43.50 per case. Lovell peaches from California are in rather slow demand at around 75c per box. Yakima potatoes, and Oregon tomatoes were unchanged in price, although displaying an uneasy market tone. Green corn is in lighter demand, and moved at slightly lower values.

Cooler rainy weather resulted in almost no demand for Watermelons and melons. Prices of \$1.25-\$1.50 were established. Several recent carlot watermelon purchases have been made by the buyer merely testing freight charges from California.

Collard cauliflowers continue in good demand at \$2.25 per standard crate. The season's first carlot shipments from the Roseburg-Dillard district are being made. A day. Heretofore, active northwestern demand has taken the entire output, by motor-truck.

First carlot receipts of 12-bushel onions moved readily to the Portland jobbing trade at \$1.10 per cwt. Quality is excellent.

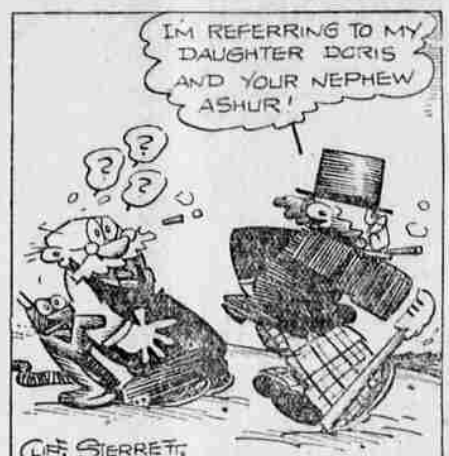
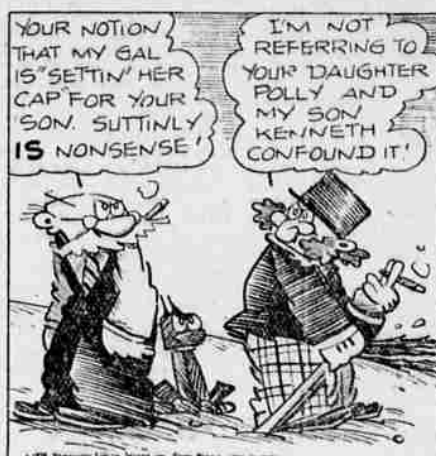
